## NEW "SPICE ON ICE" APR. 8 AT HACIENDA

The premier of the totally new third edition of "Spice on Ice" in the Fiesta Showroom at the Hacienda Hotel has been set for April 8, according to Hacienda president Roy Warren.

The noted producing-directing team of George Arnold and Bill Moore, together with executive producer Paul Lowden, have surrounded themselves with top talent in preparing the only ice skating production show in Las Vegas. "Spice on Ice '75" is being choreographed by Ron Merrin and Rene Dellaven; Tony Sabitino, set designer for the new ice show, has

been associated with television productions, including the popular syndicated show, "Soul Train;" and Bill Campbell of Los Angeles designed the dazzling, exciting costumes.
