To the 4,500 Jews in Syria, we pray for their speedy deliverance so that they too may be able to mark our joyous festival as free men.

To Jews the world over, we express our determination to press forward in fighting the scourges of hatred and bigotry, and in fulfilling our responsibility in furthering the welfare of our people and Jewish continuity. To those who feel oppressed at the magnitude of our problems and of the menace of those who would destroy us, let us take heed from the ancient message that has inspired us and all who have sought freedom throughout the centuries: "This year we are slaves; next year may we be free men."

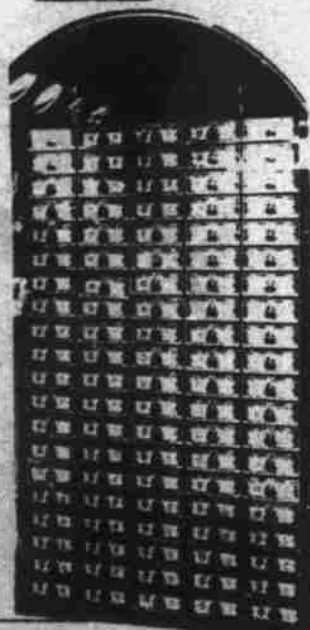
