



HOLOCAUST, A GENERATION AFTER

NEW YORK (WNS) -- A four-day "International Scholars Conference on the Holocaust -- A Generation After" demonstrated that scholars have still not come to terms with the enormity of the Nazi crime and even how to study it.

Some 40 scholars from North America, Europe and Israel participated in the event sponsored by the Institute of Contemporary History of Hebrew University and the United Jewish Appeal.

Yehuda Bauer, head of the Institute, said the purpose of the conference was to stimulate discussion out of which will hopefully appear material and books to influence students for many years to come.

Raul Hilberg, professor of political science at the University of Vermont and the author of "The Destruction of European Jewry" said the Jewish reaction to Nazi rule has implications for today because of the search

by Jews for identity. But Emil L. Fackenheim, professor of philosophy at the University of Toronto, said the study should concentrate on how a civilized country in the center of 20th Century Europe could murder one-third of the Jewish people. He said Germans should be studying this and if they are not doing it then Jews should. Fackenheim said the creation of the State of Israel was the only "total act of defiance" to the Holocaust.

Shlomo Avineri, Dean of Hebrew University's Faculty of Social Sciences, declared that the new anti-Semitism is expressed by those who deny the legitimacy of the State of Israel because they are also denying the legitimacy of the Jewish people.
