KISSINGER'S EFFORTS FUTILE

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger suspended his efforts to achieve a second-stage disengagement agreement between Israel and Egypt and flew back to Washington to report to President Ford. State Department spokesman Robert Anderson issued a statement by Kissinger in which, while noting both sides have made an effort to reach an agreement, he said that "the differences on a number of key issues have proven irreconcilable. We therefore believe a period of reassessment is needed so that all concerned can consider how best to proceed towards a lasting peace."

Israeli Premier Yitzhak Rabin also told a news conference that those involved would now want to reassess their positions before decisions were made on future moves toward a settlement. Rabin declined to predict what such future moves might be, but said he hoped that a "renewal of the present efforts lies

The Rape of Journalism

In our small voice we will shout as loud and as often as we can that Sun publisher Hank Greenspun's deceit of the American public is far more serious and far more destructive than Watergate.

The calamity in Washington, which Sen. Sam Ervin said was a bigger tragedy in U.S. history than the Civil War, brought about the demise of a President and convictions and jailings of persons in the highest offices. But their violations, once proven, were punishable by courts of law. The United States continues to function as a nation under our Constitution.

On the other hand, Greenspun's outrageous infringements of Freedom of the Press, is sapping, destroying, murdering the fundamental right granted us in the very same Constitution. His unfair, indecent and dishonest exploitation of the "Power of the Press," FOR HIS OWN PERSONAL GAIN, is not only a rape of the newspaper profession, but also could lead to a crumbling of the American way of life. Any undermining of this cardinal freedom granted in the first article of the Bill of Rights, which could impair that necessary factor for honest publishers and newspapermen, could be the beginning of the end for all of us.

Greenspun has been for years, and is, violating this cherished edict, from deliberate falsehoods to sly innuendos, ruining reputations, wrecking lives -- and all for his own selfish purpose. He has no regard or respect for due process. All this in the guise of Freedom of the Press.

Just a month ago at a West Coast media forum, Greenspun said he would cross the line of legality to get the information on a story. His qualification showed the true character of this reckless fraud: "When I say get the information it DOESN'T ALWAYS mean by illegal means." From this we gather that SOMETIMES Greenspun will break the law for a story. To which we add, and always the story will involve Greenspun's personal, monetary benefit.

Here is a publisher who has screamed about illicit wiretapping on the part of lawmen and other infringements on our Constitutional rights boldly admitting it is okay for him to break the law in his own behalf.

And only two months ago when Greenspun was asked "You obviously have a great deal of respect for the law?" Greenspun answered: "Who can help it when you grow up wanting to be something of a Clarence Darrow -- a man should be able to look at the courts as his
