"BIG JULIE" WEINTRAUB HOSTS HIS FOURTH ANNUAL SPRING CELEBRITY GOLF TOURNAMENT ON THE DUNES 'EMERALD GREEN' GOLF COURSE APRIL 25, 26. ED MARINARO, MINNESOTA VIKING, RETURNS TO DEFEND HIS LAURELS WON LAST YEAR.

The Dunes Hotel and Country Club's Spring Celebrity Golf tournament hosted by "Big" Julie Weintraub gets underway Friday, April 25 on the Dunes 'Emerald Green' Golf Course.

The 36-hole event will honor some of the biggest names in the world of football, baseball greats and entertainment celebrities will also compete and join in the social activities planned in conjunction with the tournament.

Those who have indicated they will play in the two-day classic include Oakland Raiders George Blanda, Mike Stanni Gene Upshaw, Phil Villapiano and Coach John Madden. The Los Angeles Ram roster reads like Rick Saul, David Ray, Dave Elmdorff, Jack Youngblood, Les Josephson and Steve Preise.

The Vikings will be represented by Bill Brown, Roy Winston, and Ed Marinaro. Other stars of the football world include Rich Caster, New York Jets; Mike Lucci, Detroit Lions; Jan Stenerud and Ed Podolak of Kansas City Chief fame; Cleveland Brown's Frank Scott; New York Giant Bob Tucker; Deacon Jones of the Redskins; and Jerry Philbin of the Eagles. Joining these football heroes will be baseball immortals Joe DiMaggio and Ralph Branca; Frank Fitzsimmons. Presi-

dent of the Teamsters Union, Hollywood actors Jim Herbert and Jack Albertson (of "Chico and the Man" fame) singer Jerry Vale, and comedians Bob Newhart and Corbett Monica. After announcing the names of the celebrities, Weintraub issued an invitation to the public and press to join their favorites on the golf course Friday and Saturday.

SHIRLEY MACLAINE, PAT COOPER AT MGM GRAND

Stage and screen star Shirley MacLaine brought her rollicking nightclub revue back to the Celebrity Room of the MGM Grand.

On the same four-week bill will be comic Pat Cooper, long regarded as one of the best "warm-up" comedians on the Strip.

Ms. MacLaine, best known for her Academy Award-winning film roles, is fast becoming one of the most accomplished cabaret performers on any of the four par three holes.

As is the custom following each tournament, the Dunes Hotel will donate a sum of money to charity.

This year's recipients of over \$8,000 was announced by Weintraub. They include the St. Rosa de Lima Hospital in Henderson, the Las Vegas Kidney Foundation, the Dawn Hancock School for handicapped children, New York's Kingsbrook Jewish Medical Center. A new fund will also be established to provide monies to build a nursery for New York welfare New York welfare mothers.

Dunes head professional Dom Hamblin is in charge of the tournament, which is free to the public.

Country music's all-time superstar, Eddy Arnold, is back in Las Vegas for the first time in several years, headlining an all-new show in the

Congo Room of Del Webb's Sahara. Appearing with Arnold are mad-cap comedian George Gobel and The Establishment. Arnold has been making and breaking records for more than twenty years and is currently listed among the top four recording artists of all time. His total record sales recently exceeded the 70,000,000 mark.

In 1966, he was elected to the Country Music Hall of Fame, a fitting tribute to the man who has personally brought country music to millions of people all over the world. The following year, he was named "Entertainer of the Year" by the Country Music Association.

Eddy refers to himself as "a Heinz 57 singer -- I sing many different kinds of songs which mean something to many different kinds of people." Whatever the mixture, Eddy's songs

have his warm and mellow voice as a permanent ingredient.

Some of Eddy's memorable hits include "Boquet of Roses," "Cattle Call," "Make the World Go Away," "That's How Much I Love You," "Lonely Again," "Misty Blue" and "Turn the World Around the Other Way." He co-authored two favorites "You Don't Know Me" and "Just a Little Lovin'."

If Eddy's singing and performance have become more cosmopolitan, more traditionally "pop" they have, nevertheless, retained the down-to-earth quality of the Country genre. The music, like the man, is a rare synthesis of the rural and the urban, the folksy and the sophisticated. It is, perhaps, this combination which accounts for Eddy's enormous universal appeal, both as a performer and a human being.
