

**ROY WOOFER FOR CITY COMMISSION 3**

Declaring, "I've hated the prospect of giving up a career in public service," former Clark County District Attorney Roy Woofler filed as a candidate for City Commission.

Woofler relied heavily on his record as a district attorney in pointing out his qualifications for seeking the Ward 3 seat.

Woofler said that while district attorney, not one new pornographic movie house or book store opened in the county, and no massage parlors were able to get a foothold.

During the same period, he said, "Pornography was flourishing in the City of Las Vegas."

"I feel I can help to effect the same type of cooperation we had in the county, and use my experience to help fight the flood of pornography in the city," he said.

Woofler claimed proper management of tax dollars and proper administration of

municipal departments are the key issues in the campaign.

He pointed out that while district attorney he had a staff of nearly 100 and a \$1 million budget.

"At the end of my term, I am proud to be able to say that I was able to return money from my budget to the county," he

said.

He said his knowledge of all of the county government departments would be "helpful in the event any plan for consolidation is put into action."

Woofler added that working for senior citizens and with youth would be necessary for a city commissioner and he has experience in both fields.

He pointed out he has served for several years on the Senior Citizens' R.S.V.P. Board and also created the District Attorney's Youth Advisory Council which was active in every high school while he was district attorney.

He also pointed out that while district attorney his office had a 90 per cent criminal conviction record. "I think my prosecution experience will help in drafting and voting on ordinances that will help to fight crime in the city," he said.

Woofler said his decision to seek the office was neither a hasty one nor a well planned political move.

"The only people in this world that I have consulted about this decision are my father and my law partner," he said.

Commenting on the district attorney election, Woofler said he was proud that both he and Holt ran "clean races." He added, "I was beaten fairly by a good man who seems to be doing a good job."

"To be perfectly honest, however," he continued, "I've hated the prospect of giving up a career in public service. So, since I feel I am qualified to help the city through many of its present difficulties, I am filing for the city commission seat in District 3."
