"The Stories of Ali Darwish and Hanna Meron," the fourth program in the series "Arabs and Israelis," Saturday night, May 3 at 6:30 p.m. on Channel 10, is composed of two intense, deeply revealing film portraits. One is the story of a poetic young man, Ali Darwish, who returns to the site of his bombed-out house in Suez, to reminisce on the life he and his family used to live there. He cries out - in the most human of terms - at the tragedy that has swept away his place, and with it his sense of belonging. The second portrait is that of a well-known Israeli actress, Hanna Meron, whose leg was blown off during a terrorist attack at Munich airport. She describes the day of the incident, her longing during the long months of recovery to return to the stage, and her desire - above all - to play Medea because of what she had learned from her experience.
