

ALLON NORMALIZES RELATIONS WITH FRANCE

PARIS (WNS) -- Israeli Foreign Minister Yigal Allon completed a three-day official visit to Paris marking a return to normal relations between Israel and France ending the animosity and bitterness that has existed since the 1967 Six-Day War. It was the first official visit to France by an Israeli leader. Allon met with President Valery Giscard d'Estaing, Prime Minister Jacques Chirac and Foreign Minister Jean Sauvagnargues as well as with French Jewish leaders. Allon told newsmen he had been received with understanding, friendship and cordiality even though important points of disagreement existed between Israel and France. Allon said the two countries discussed bilateral relations, Israel's desire to have closer ties with

the European Economic Community and the issue of peace. The latter issue provided the only real major difference between the two countries. Giscard d'Estaing reportedly advised Allon that it would be better for Israel to reach an agreement with the Arabs now than later since time is on the side of the Arabs. The French also believe that the Palestinians should be a negotiating partner and that no solution can be reached without their participation.

They believe that international guarantees should be sufficient to reduce Israel's needs for what it considers defensible borders and the French are also pressing for the broadest negotiations for an overall settlement at Geneva at the earliest date. Allon reportedly told the French leaders that Israel did not fear broad negotiations and would return to Geneva providing that adequate preparations had been made in advance. But Allon warned that if the Geneva talks failed, the Mideast situation would revert to another period of stagnation and the prospects of another war would be more serious.

AJC URGES STRONG SUPPORT FOR ISRAEL

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Bertram H. Gold, executive vice-president of the American Jewish Committee, urged Jews to be more forceful and sophisticated than ever before in countering the arguments against support to Israel and in demonstrating "how the whole range of America's security requirements are advanced by a strong Israel."

Speaking at the AJC committee's 69th annual meeting, Gold expressed the hope that when the Ford Administration completes its reassessment of American Middle East policy, the U.S. commitment to Israel's security will be reaffirmed, along with the commitment "to provide the economic and military lifeline she needs."

Gold urged that American Jews "have the obligation to be more forthcoming with the Israelis about our views, particularly when those views may be critical of Israeli positions -- positions which could diminish urgently

needed American support. And by the same token, the Israelis have the reciprocal obligation not only to listen but to hear."
