# AJC URGES STRONG SUPPORT FOR ISRAFL

NEW YORK (WNS) --Bertram H. Gold. executive vice - president of the American Jewish Committee, urged Jews to be more forceful and sophisti-cated than ever before in countering the arguments against support to Israel and in demonstrating "how the whole range of America's security requirements are advanced by strong Israel." the

Speaking at AJCommittee's annual meeting, Gold expressed the hope that when the Ford Adminis-tration completes its reassessment American Middle East policy, the U.S. commitsecurity will be affirmed, along with the commitment "to pro-vide the economic and military lifeline needs.

Gold urged that American Jews "have the obligation to be more forthcoming with the Israelis about our views, particularly when those views may be critical of Israeli positions -- positions which could diminish urgently

needed American support, And by the same token, the Israelis have the reciprocal obligation not only to listen but to hear."
