## "COUNTRY MUSIC U.S.A." OPENS IN JUBILEE SHOWROOM OF LANDMARK ON MAY 12

The Landmark Hotel salutes America's Bi-centennial with America's own music -- country/western -- as "Country Music U.S.A." opens in the Jubilee Showroom Monday, May 12 for an indefinite engagement.

Leading off the parade of country music personalities that will be appearing at the hotel will be Epic Recording star Bob Luman, who made his professional debut in Las Vegas during the early '60's on a bill with Johnny Cash and Tex Ritter.

The return to the city of one of its most favorite sons comes on the heels of Luman's latest recording hit "Proud Of You Baby," which is currently high

on the charts. Bob's career began as an avid listener of

The Grand Ole Opry. His launching pad was Shreveport's "Louisiana Hayride" followed at the tender age of 17 by a part in the movie "Carnival Rock" and the Vegas appearance.

Though the fans were many, the hits were few and Luman decided to pursue a Pirates' baseball offer -- a move which never materialized due to the fact that he was stopped short with a hit pitched to him by the Everly Brothers entitled "Let's Think About Living" -- a million seller which reached number one on the country charts

and was among the top three R & B.

Another hit "The Great Snowman" and Uncle Sam beckoned. Upon his return, Bob bounced back on Epic Records with such hits as "When You Say Love," "Lonely Women Make Good Lovers," "Neither One Of Us," "Still Loving You" and "Let Me Make The Bright Lights Shine For You."

The Luman style has been as consistent as his nationally-charted hits; a style that blends his rock 'n roll rhythms with his country background, creating a musical sound that is appreciated more today than ever before.

Backing the country man is (in his own words) "the best four-piece band on the road," "The Stones River Band." Together they have played a multitude of Vegas clubs and state fairs across the country.

Also featured in the show are Eddie Raven (current hit -- "Good News, Bad News"), Debbie Campbell (current hit -- "Please Tell Him I Said Hello"), the Wind Song Trio and extra attraction, banjo/humorist Skip Devol.
