REDIVIDING JERUSALEM UNTHINKABLE

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- It would be unthinkable to redivide Jerusalem, Simon de Beauvoir, the noted French novelist and philosopher, declared as she received the Jerusalem Prize from Mayor Teddy Kollek at the opening of the Seventh International Book Fair here.

She also denounced UNESCO for its "stupid and discriminatory" resolutions against Israel over its activities in Jerusalem. She noted that her own tour of the city showed her that Israel's new buildings did not spoil the character of the city. The archaeological digs, the subject of UNESCO's action against Israel, did not ruin the Arab character of the city, but uncovered the buried glories of the city's

Moslem history along with its historical treasures during other ages, de Beauvoir asserted.

She said she generally refuses prizes, but had decided to accept the Jerusalem Prize and attend the ceremony to demonstrate her love for Israel. De Beauvoir said UNESCO had sought to "symbolically" eradicate Israel. But symbolism could quickly turn into reality, she said.

The prize was awarded to de Beauvoir for her contribution to "the freedom of the individual." The judges, headed by Supreme Court Justice Haim Cohn, singled out her work, "The Second Sex," as a "deep work of research" into the role of women in a free society. Some 60,000 books from 750 publishers in 43 countries are displayed at the book fair.

This Week in Carson City

Three bills were introduced in the Assembly on mass transit for the Las Vegas Valley. One would allow Regional States and Highway Commission to receive and disburse Federal funds; another would direct the Legislative Commission to study problems of mass transit in Clark County during the biennium; a third proposes that the Public Service Commission be able to establish reduced rates for specified routes or schedules to promote ridership.

The Joint Committees on Judiciary set up to speak with special Washington, D.C. counsel to advise them on the constitutional questions involved in the bill proposing to license officials of unions in the gaming industry.

The Assembly Judiciary Committee heard testimony in support of a bill proposing to remove juvenile traffic offenses from District to Justice and Municipal Courts in Clark County.

Resolutions which would be required to pass both Houses in this session and the 1977 Legislature before going on the ballot in 1978 proposes to make murder in the first degree a non-bailable offense under any circumstances.

A bill to ease the trauma through which rape victims go when their case is taken to court was passed by the Assembly and sent to the Governor. Its major provision would refuse to allow the probing of defense attorney into the previous sex life of the rape victim.

A package of nine bills aimed at relieving the high costs of medical malpractice insurance were received in the Assembly. A series of eight bills to strengthen the professional engineer statute were passed in the Assembly and sent to the Senate for action.
