Throughout the mid 60's, while still in his teens he sang with many bands on the gulf coast. However, he tired of this life and returned to writing, starting out with such big hits as "Country Green" a top five record for

Don Gibson, "Good Morning Country Rain" for Jeannie C. Riley, "Touch The Morning" for Don Gibson and other hits for the three Roys -- Orbison, Acuff and Clark.
