## SHEVUOTH FESTIVAL AT TEMPLE BETH SHOLOM

The lovely two-day Shevuoth holiday will be celebrated in traditional fashion at Temple Beth Sholom. The festival began at sundown on Thursday and ends at sundown Saturday. Services will be held in the Temple's main Sanctuary in accordance with the following schedule:

Friday evening - 8:30 P.M.

Friday and Saturday mornings - 9:00 A.M.

Yizkor memorial services will be held on Saturday at approximately 11:00 A.M.

In Jewish tradition Shevuoth has its chief significance as the day of the Giving of the Law, the day on which the Jewish people received the Ten Commandments at Mt. Sinai. The holiday is called Pentecost. The word is from the Greek meaning 50 since the holiday occurs exactly 50 days after Passover. Shevuoth is also known as the "Festival of Harvest," and the "Festival of the First Fruits." It was at this
