TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Although there was no official government reaction to the fall of South Vietnam to the Viet Cong, the average Israeli saw gloomy implications for the integrity of American commitments to Israel.

Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger's reassuring words to America's friends at a White House press conference that the U.S. would stand by its commitments, had an ambiguous ring to many Israelis. Kissinger said "One lesson we must learn from this experience (Vietnam) is that we must be very careful in the commitments we make, but that we should scrupulously honor those commitments we make." The fact that Kissinger made this general reply to a specific question as to whether the failure in Vietnam meant that the U.S. will never again come to the military or economic aid of any ally, such as Israel, was seen by many Israelis as a deliberate evasion.
