NEW YORK -- Warning against "Trojan horses within the American-Jewish community Dr. Joseph P. Sternstein, President of the Zionist Organization of America, cautioned against those who are pressuring Israel to be "moderate" when all the facts indicate that she has offered far-reaching concessions that have been rejected by the Arabs. In view of an unprecedented policy of "a diplomatic war of nerves," Sternstein urges Israel, her leaders and world Jewry, to keep steadfast and not panic.

Anticipating tremendous pressures exerted upon Israel, Sternstein urged resistance to the possibility that the Administration would foist its own proposals for a solution and reiterated the ZOA position rejecting retreat to the lines of 1967. Concluding, Dr. Sternstein stated, "Israel, together with American Jewry, will continue to proceed in its efforts to interpret the position to our respective to the state of her position to our government, which we know maintains basic friendship for her.

"But, it remains for the American-Jewish community, from every area and from every level of influence, led by an inspired and committed Zionist movement, to make certain that the American people continues without interruption or hesitation to maintain its long and traditional support for Israel."
