HADASSAH RAPS WORLD HEALTH ORG.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Mrs. Rose Matzkin, president of Hadassah, has sent a letter to the head of the World Health Organization, Dr. S.A. Malafatopolous, declaring that the WHO's condemnation of Israel's treatment of the residents of the administered territories is "an action which lowers the moral value of WHO and casts doubts on the validity of its work."

The Hadassah Medical Organization's na-

tional board meanwhile plans to review its membership in the United States Association for World Health, an affiliate of WHO. Mrs. Matzkin in her letter said that after the 1967 war, hundreds of Arabs came to Hadassah for medical treatment "after years of neglect by the Arab government" of the West Bank and Jerusalem.

"The health standards in those areas are higher today than ever," she said, "the mortality rate is lower." Mrs. Matzkin cited the medical services provided by Hadassah-Hebrew University Medical Center in Jerusalem to Arab residents of Gaza, the West Bank, "and even Jordan" in addition to primary health care services in hospitals and clinics.

She noted that the WHO Assembly had condemned Israel "despite the report of the WHO investigator approving of Israel's health services to those areas."

RABIN NAMES SHARON AS ADVISOR

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Despite opposition from within his own government, Premier Yitzhak Rabin has named former Likud leader Gen. (Res.) Ariel Sharon as his special advisor on security matters, a civilian post.

The Premier acted on his prerogative to appoint advisors without Cabinet approval in order to end the public debate on the fitness of Sharon to occupy such a sensitive post within a government whose policies he has severely criticized. Sharon, the founder of the anti-Labor

Likud, resigned from the Knesset earlier this year to return to the army and will continue in his senior post in the reserves. The appointment was seen as the first step to

implementing the Agranat Committee's recommendation for the creation of National Security Council.

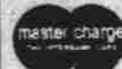
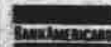
