**This Week in Carson City**

With this column the weekly reports on the actions of the 1975 Nevada Legislature come to an end. It has been the pleasure of this columnist to correspond in this manner with the people of Clark County and to cooperate with this newspaper in so doing.

Some of the significant legislation signed by the Governor since adjournment of the Legislature include a measure setting up a procedure for enforcing assessment liens against owners of condominiums who refuse to meet their obligations. AB 108 revised and strengthened the law on child abuse and neglect. AB 192 protects the rights of children by changing procedures in the termination of parental rights of parents who do not take their responsibilities.

Some five measures dealt with the problems of substance abuse. A major one allows the civil commitment of drug addicts and alcoholics as a court diversion if they are willing and the nature of their crime is such that the court believes they may be rehabilitated by being placed in a treatment facility instead of being tried. If successful, they are excused from the trial. If not, they are to be held and tried. A second measure changes the legal procedures for civil custody of alcohol abusers. A third calls for substance abuse to be covered in health insurance policies written in the state. Another allows the Bureau of Alcohol and Drug Abuse to license facilities and certify counselors. An early measure outlaws the use of liquid silicone for injection into the body.

A little noticed bill of considerable significance was AB 609 which was introduced on April 11 and passed by the Assembly on May 6. It moves juvenile traffic offenses in Clark County to justice and municipal court on July 1, 1976. The Juvenile Court of Clark County asked for it to alleviate some of its overload and to solve some of its problems of transporting juveniles from outlying areas for this purpose.
