

**4 AMERICAN FIRMS CHARGED BY ADL**

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The B'nai B'rith Anti-Defamation League has filed legal charges with the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission against four American corporations charging them with anti-Jewish discrimination in their hiring policies and violating the civil rights of Americans. The ADL accused Aramco Service Co. Texas; Bendix-Sylvania, Maryland; Hospital Corporation of America, Tennessee, and International School Services, Princeton, N. J. of accepting and complying with the anti-Jewish practices of Saudi Arabia and Abu-Dubai by "screening out Jews from employment in the Arab world."

Arnold Forster, ADL's general counsel, said Aramco, the world's largest oil company, was demanding baptismal certificates from

candidates seeking jobs overseas, to prove they are not Jewish. Forster said the charges of discrimination are "preliminary steps to Federal Court" if the EEOC grants the ADL's application for an immediate "right to sue."

Seymour Graubard, ADL's national chairman, said the four big and powerful corporations were "deliberately selected" in order to reach "a clear and unequivocal" rule.
