STATEMENT OF POSITION

BY DR. JOSEPH P. STERNSTEIN PRES. ZIONIST ORG. OF AMERICA

We are disburbed by the present policy of the Administration which is inflicting undue pressure against Israel, contrary to the will of the American people as expressed by the Congress of the United States.

The policy of appeasement resulting in a sellout to Egypt's Sadat must be rejected by a wave of protest by all Americans who believe in fair play and are concerned with our national

This policy plays into the hands of the Soviet Union. It is a reversal of position established by all United States Presidents, who have considered Israel to be a de facto ally and important friend in the Middle East.

In addition to America's political and strategic interests which require support for Israel, there is also a moral obligation not to surrender to the profit-hungry oil companies, a price which the American people should not be forced to pay.

Present American policy fails to exercise proper respect for Israel, a proven ally, who must not be asked to give up the legitimate Continued on Page 3

Las Vegas Still Stands

From reports on national news broadcasts, you would think Las Vegas is inundated, that looting of abandoned homes is prevalent and that visitors take their lives in their hands by coming

here. Nothing could be further than the truth.

We are not going to minimize the damage caused by the flash flood on July 3, nor do we treat lightly the two lives lost in North Las Vegas. But we do think it pertinent, especially to the millions of touriest contemporaries. to the millions of tourists contemplating visiting

Las Vegas this summer, to put the unfortunate act of God in its proper perspective.

The Las Vegas Valley is a bowl, surrounded by mountains. A sudden cloudburst over the valley will cause streams of water to flow towards the center of the bowl. These streams are diverted into drainage routes, known as washes. One of the washes happens to be through a parking lot of Caesars Palace, continues on under the Strip and out into Paradise Valley. There are signs in the Caesars parking area designating the path of the wash to which little or no attention is ever paid, on the theory a roof does not leak if it is not raining.

The flash flood came without warning, causing cars to float towards the tunnel under the Strip. The tunnel became blocked and water backed up into the parking lot. Not a single life was lost, or even jeopardized at Caesars Palace, or any other casino, hotel or motel in all of

Southern Nevada.

The two lives that, unfortunately, were lost, happened many miles from Las Vegas in North Las Vegas, when the victims were trapped in a car overrun by the direct path of the flood. The news reports described the debacle in

Las Vegas by stating hundreds of cars were destroyed at Caesars Palace and two lives were lost. During the height of the flood, at about 5 p.m. on July 3, tourists continued to gamble and enjoy the hospitality of the hotels, even Caesars, without ever suspecting what was going

One visitor, whose car was destroyed, complained that there should have been notificaplained that there should have been notifica-tion over the public address system. He's lucky it was not done. If he had been notified and if he ran to the parking lot to save his car, he may have been injured or killed. Caesars Palace management is to be complimented. Caesars set up an area in the hotel for insurance adjustors to meet with patrons to settle claims.

One item should be made perfectly clear to prospective visitors and tourists. At no time was Las Vegas determined a "disaster area,"
