

**RELIGIOUS JUDGES DENOUNCE DIVORCE RULE**

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- A major confrontation between religious and secular courts in Israel is in the making in the wake of a ruling by the Supreme Court that a divorce document, though issued by a religious court, was secular in nature and subject to judicial review.

Israel's dayanim (religious court judges) have angrily denounced the ruling and declared they would not accept directives in halachic matters from any but halachic authorities. Meanwhile, the National Religious Party MKs, Zevulun

Hammer and Yehuda Ben Meir, have introduced a bill in the Knesset calling for the establishment of a special court to rule on jurisdictional disputes between the secular and rabbinical courts. They suggested that the special court be composed of one religious court judge, appointed by the Minister of Religious Affairs, and two civil court judges, appointed by the Justice Minister "after consulting with the religious Minister." The special court would thus be religiously orientated.

**ADULTEROUS RULING MAY BE REVISED**

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The Israeli Supreme Court may review a controversial ruling by one of its members which Deputy Attorney General Michael Chesin says is an infringement on the authority of the rabbinical courts.

Shimon Agranat, president of the Supreme Court, said if he decides to review the deci-

sion it will be conducted by a panel of five judges instead of the usual three. Chesin asked the court to re-examine the ruling by Justice Yoel Sussman in the case of a divorcee who was branded an adulteress in a religious divorce decree handed down by a Beersheba religious court.

Sussman ruled that the divorce decree was not a religious but a civil document and that the woman should not be stigmatized.

**GOLDMANN SAYS PEACE MUST BE NOW**

TÉL AVIV (WNS) -- If the present situation in the Middle East does not bring settlement soon, Israel may possibly lose the last chance for peace, according to Dr. Nahum Goldman, president of the World Jewish Congress.

Goldmann said in a radio interview here that now is the time for an overall settlement, not interim settlements.

He said it should include formal recognition of Israel by the Arabs, guarantees by the superpowers for an Israeli withdrawal from all occupied territories except Jerusalem and some border modifications.
