

SAMMY COHEN "WHO ELSE?" SETS CHILD HAVEN TRIP TO DISNEYLAND

On the door of Child Haven's Toddler Cottage is a sign reading: "Roller Skates for Rent, 10¢ an hour. Lessons 5¢ extra."

The residents of the facility's youth girls cottage made over \$45 at a Mexican dinner they hosted for staff and volunteers and then added another \$20 selling strawberry shortcake a few days later.

The teenage boys at Child Haven have been washing and waxing cars for the last two weeks.

Object: A trip to Disneyland.

Child Haven is Clark County's temporary home for abandoned, neglected, abused and dependent children. Many of these youngsters have had pretty grim childhoods, much less the joy of a trip to Disneyland.

But that will all change Wednesday and Thursday when about 40 youngsters from six to 18 years old board the bus for the Magic Kingdom. The satisfaction will be compounded because the children

earned the money themselves -- half of it.

Sammy Cohen, owner of Santa Anita Race Book and a long-time supporter of the youngsters who get involved with the juvenile court, is matching the money gathered with money from his Spring Mountain Youth Camp Fund.

"Thanks to Sammy the dream of many youngsters is going to become reality," said Linda Tarr, Recreation Director at Child Haven.

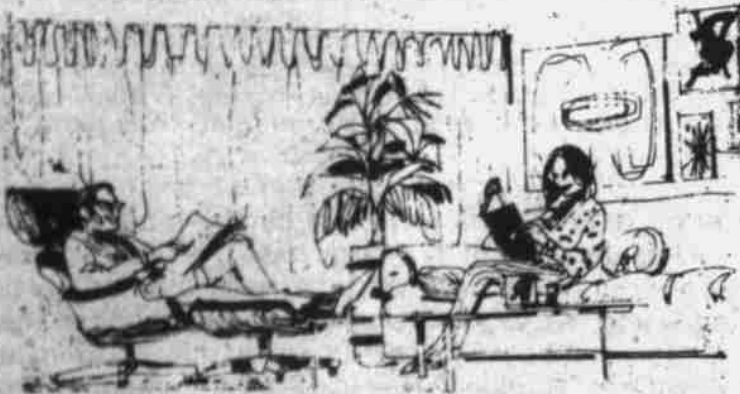
