**FREE WORLD AGAINST OUSTING ISRAEL**

TEL AVIV (WNS) Israeli Premier Yitzhak Rabin returned from Stockholm where he attended a meeting of Europe's Social-Democratic leaders in which they expressed unanimous opposition to any Third World attempt to suspend or expel Israel from the UN.

Rabin said here he hoped the entire free world would act against the Arab attempt to oust Israel.

Before Rabin's departure from Stockholm, he met for 90 minutes with UN Sec'y Gen. Kurt Waldheim. Waldheim said they had discussed all as-

pects of the expulsion issue as well as the United States effort to bring about a second Sinai interim agreement. Rabin said here that he did not go into details of the Sinai negotiations while in Stockholm. He said Israel is presently waiting for Egypt's reply on Israel's demand that she make concessions.

The Socialist stand on the expulsion issue was outlaid at a press conference by Swedish Prime Minister Olaf Palme. He said the 11 European leaders "are all completely unanimous" that attempts to expel or suspend Israel from the UN would violate the world organization charter and would have "grave consequences" for the future of the

UN.

The move against any attempt at Israel's expulsion also received a boost when the Arab bloc at the Organization of African Unity summit meeting was unable to win endorsement of a resolution calling for Israel's expulsion from the UN. After a 12-hour debate the OAU summit meeting approved a watered-down resolution calling on the OAU countries "to take the most adequate measures to reinforce the pressure exerted on Israel at the United Nations and its specialized agencies, including the possibility of eventually depriving it of its membership in these institutions." Among the nation's opposing a direct call for Israel's expulsion was Egypt, apparently out of concern for an

adverse impact in the Sinai talks. Five countries were listed as having reservations about the resolution with Zaire saying it was "totally against" it. In another development, the Australian and New Zealand government announced their opposition to exclude Israel from the UN. Cambodia, however, has called for Israel's expulsion.

American public is good for Israel. As we have said previously, Israel and the United States are the only countries on a direct line, seeking peace in this world and progress for mankind.

Judge Ribner is knowledgeable of world affairs and deeply concerned with ALL American veteran problems. He said the Veterans Administration has "vastly improved" since the appointment of Richard Roudebush as administrator, who is "cleaning up the mess." But Ribner stated he was on record for even further improvements, like veteran hospitals in certain areas, including Southern Nevada.

Ribner, a personable, soft-spoken spokesman for JWV with world leaders, said his attempts to speak personally with Egyptian Premier Sadat have not been successful and the offer still stands for the Arab leader to address the JWV in the future. Ribner quoted Israeli Premier Rabin, that "Israel will never put itself at a military disadvantage unless a secure and firm peace agreement is formally negotiated."

If Pres. Ford re-submits the proposed \$350 million Jordan Arms sale to Congress, Ribner predicts it will be defeated, not just because the JWV is against it, but for the reason it is not in the best interest of the U. S. government. "The ultra sophisticated weapons, fully mobile, could be used offensively," he said, "and could fall into the hands of the Russians."

Ribner said the only way he could see Israel having a talk with the PLO is if the Palestinians themselves, oust the current leaders, with their terrorist and murdering tactics, and install new leaders, who have honest interests in their hearts.

Judge Ribner said he is a candidate for re-election as commander and expects to be successful.
