The multi-talented strawberry blonde sings, dances and has special material segments that showcase her talents as an actress-comedienne.....Another "Casino" star, FAY McKAY is back in town as special guest star in the new MICKEY FINN SHOW, now at the Stardust Lounge. Same show is comedy ventriloquist SAMMY KING whose Vegas credits include "Folies Bergere" and "Fancy That".....Country favorite and Mr. Haney of tv's "Green Acres", PAT BUTTRAM is special guest in the newest and sixth edition of JIM HALSEY'S "COUNTRY MUSIC, U.S.A." now at the Landmark Hotel....DEBBIE REYNOLDS who'll be returning to the Desert Inn on August 19, is also scheduled for a Nov-Dec stint at the D.I. to be followed two days after closing by - and first appearance - across the street at the Frontier Hotel on December 10. Debbie's fellow-Hughes star WAYNE NEWTON (at the Sands till September 30) will have two whole months before he's set to open at the Frontier in November, and back to the Sands for the Christmas and New Year's engagement opening Dec. 10.....JOHN DAVIDSON who's been postponing his return to Vegas to do television, joins the 5th Dimension at the Riviera in October.....Songstress ROZ CLARK, a former member of The Celebration, who's been on her own for about a year, and records for Warner Brothers, guests with BILL COSBY at Harrah's Tahoe, with the possibility of making her Vegas mainroom debut with Cosby in September at the Hilton......DICK CLARK'S "GOOD OL" ROCK "N ROLL" REVUE starring LACKIE WILSON ROCK 'N ROLL" REVUE starring JACKIE WILSON, CORNELL GUNTHER and THE COASTERS, and DION opens tonight at the Thunderbird Hotel. Said Dick at his smash opening last year at the Hilton: "I had to wait for all of you (his audience) to grow up before I could come to Las Vegas with a show." Clark's Bandstanders turn out by the droves to join him on his trip down the musical memory lanes of the 50's, 60's and 70's!!......
