### Phoney Refugee Issue

The plight of the Palestinian refugees has been used effectively by Arab propagandists. It is the chief weapon in their attempt to oust Israel from the United Nations. Who can deny the plight of the Palestinians who live in refugee camps?

What can be denied is that it is the fault of Israel. The world must be continually reminded that the refugees are in the camps as the result of Arab policy, past and present.

It is sometimes forgotten that the UN voted in 1947 to establish two states in the British mandate of Palestine--one Arab and one Jewish. The Arab state was never established because the Arab countries immediately attacked Israel in an attempt to destroy it. The Kingdom of Jordan annexed the West Bank. It was the Arab states which caused most Arabs living in what is now Israel to flee their homes in expectation of an Arab victory. It was also the Arab states who decided that the refugees should remain in camps to be used as a political weapon against Israel.

Compare the situation of the refugees in camps in Arab countries to that of the refugees who have lived under so-called Israeli occupation since 1967. The former occupants of camps on the West Bank and the Gaza Strip have under Israeli rule been able to earn a decent living for the first time. It should also not be forgotten that the Arabs who left Israel are balanced by an equal number of Jews who fled Arab countries after 1948.

The Wall Street Journal, in a recent series on refugees, noted there are more refugees today throughout the world than ever before. Most, no matter whatever hope they may still have about returning to their native land, try to make a new life for themselves in their adopted country. The recent agreement between West Germany and Poland in which 100,000 ethnic Germans will be allowed to leave Poland for Germany is an example. There was not even the slightest hint anyone thought Germany had a right to take back

the land it lost to Poland in World War II. Only the Palestinians, living among their fellow Arabs, demand they be given "their land at the expense of the existence of Israel. It is time the refugee issue be taken out of the area of propaganda and the Arab states use their oil-rich treasuries to improve the conditions of these people rather than for the tools of war.

### PLO Guerrillas Boast UN Endorses Them

UNITED NATIONS, (WUP)--Yasir Arafat's guerillas, who are continuing their murderous onslaughts against Israel from Lebanon on an almost day-to-day basis, maintain that the United Nations by its recent decision has approved their actions.

In a strongly-worded letter addressed to the Secretary-General, Pinchas Eliav, the Acting Permanent Representative of Israel to the UN, complained that the PLO "has been boasting that its missions of murder carried out against Israeli civilians were endorsed, in advance, by the recent resolutions of the General Assembly and of the corresponding bodies of the Specialized Agencies. Those resolutions," Mr. Eliav charged, "have become a source of encouragement and support for the terror activities of the PLO."

He thus warned Mr. Waldheim "that Israel has the right and indeed the duty to take all the necessary steps for the protection of its citizens and its territory."

Even while this letter was being delivered here last week, the Israeli Defense Forces moved against several guerrilla bases in the Tyre region by air and by sea inflicting heavy losses. Intelligence in Israel had been alerted of the fact that these strongly-armed bases were training several suicide guerrilla squads for a concentrated attack on Israel's northern villages. Thanks to this intelligence--coming from certain sources in Lebanon opposed to the Palestinian terrorists--the Israelis were enabled to thwart such an attack and thus save many innocent lives.

Referring to the raids in the Tyre area, Defense Minister Shimon Peres told news men that they were "preventive and not punitive." He also indicated that Israel is intent on wiping out all guerrilla nests through out Lebanon whose regime has been unable to deal with the terrorists who have brought the nation to the brink of a civil war.

In this regard, there can be no doubt that the non-Moslem Arab community in Lebanon---representing half the population of the nation and even the more moderate Moslems---would be more than happy to see the Israelis 'solve' its Palestinian terrorist issue which is jeopardizing the security of the regime since the Beirut Government itself is in no position to do what King Hussein did in 1970 when he drove Arafat's gangsters out of his country.

The clamor raised by some naive writers and diplomats to the effect that the Israeli Government open the door for negotiations

with the PLO guerrillas on the question of the West Bank was countered by this definitive reply from Premier Yitzhak Rabin: "The only language they understand is that of the sword--and it is in that language we shall talk to them."

The dictatorial leaders of the Arab states are fully aware of Israel's position relative to the PLO murderers. Despite this fact, they are insisting that Arafat's gang be granted sovereign status in the West Bank, and in this they stand they have the full support of the Soviets along with the Third World countries in addition to a growing number of Western states, the latter of whom, including the U.S., are not ignorant of the publicly-stated PLO scheme to undo the Jewish State.

So long as such a state of affairs exists and so long as this world organization and some of its Specialized Agencies are conferring a legal status upon the PLO as they have done there can be no hope of an overall settlement of the Middle East dispute and for this the "tyranny of the majority" within the United Nations must take full responsibility.

Consequently, as far as Israel is concerned, only one course is left open for her---to remain strong and alert but also ready to negotiate with anyone of the Arab states that will show a genuine change of heart.

That Israel today is militarily mighty was confirmed recently by the Times' military correspondent, Drew Middleton, who had made a tour of all the Middle East states. Said he: "The military balance is in Israel's favor, so much so that a fifth Arab-Israeli war---even a limited one began by the Arabs for political objectives, like that of 1973---appears foolhardy...."

HOUSTON (WNS) ---The United States should provide trade concessions to Israel as a counter measure to the Arab boycott, Sen. Lloyd Bentsen (D.Tex.) told a meeting of the B'nai B'rith board of governors.

WASHINGTON (WNS)--During the airport ceremony marking President Ford's arrival in Bucharest, Ford shook hands with a representative of the Palestine Liberation Organization, State Department spokesman Robert Anderson said.

TEL AVIV (WNS)--The agreement by which West Germany will pay Poland one billion marks for work done by Polish labor under the Nazi regime in return for allowing 100,000 ethnic Germans living in Poland to come to West Germany was criticized here by Tuvia Friedman, head of the Nazi War Crimes Documentation Center in Haifa. He said the Polish laborers were chiefly Jews and the 100,000 Jewish survivors from Poland had received almost nothing in payments from German.
