ARAB BANKERS PLEDGE NON-DISCRIMINATION

HOUSTON---Arab partners in a proposed New York bank which would finance U. S.-Arab trade have pledged to "comply fully" with non-discrimination laws.

This was disclosed to a B'nai B'rith audience by a prominent Houston banker who is a major force behind the new enterprise.

Ben Love, chair

man of the board of Texas Commerce Bank, told a public forum at the biannual meeting of B'nai B'rith's board of governors that 22 Arab banks who are part of multinational consortium have specifically agreed to adhere to "principles of equality and non-discrimination" in "every aspect" of the new bank's operations.

The pledge by the Arab shareholders seemingly ignores Arab boycott policies.

Love said that the new bank, would serve American economic interests by assisting in the recycling of petrodollars, declaring, "If the dollars going to oil-producing nations do not come back as investments or as payment for goods, nations of the world face bankruptcy, economic upheaval, and

political turmoil."

Love's bank is one of four in the U.S. which have applied for a charter in New York. Other partners are from Great Britain, France, Italy and Japan.

Love said his own bank, which is involved in Houston's oil commerce with the Middle East, has

Jewish officers, directors, and "a substantial volume of Jewish business," and had "never been pressured by any group--Arab or other wise--to lessen these ties as a condition for conducting normal business transactions. If the question ever arose, he stated, "we would refuse to do so."
