

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

WASHINGTON, D. C. ---The American Revolution Bicentennial Administration has produced a 13 minute color movie which may be rented or purchased by writing the Nat'l. Audiovisual Center, Washington, D.C. 20409.

JERUSALEM, (WUP)--Dr. Bruce Dollish, A Weizmann Institute scientist is developing an ultrasonic device which produces a three dimensional image for more efficient and accurate diagnosis of unsuspected cancer, it was announced here.

MILWAUKEE (WNS)--After visitors to the opening day of the Wisconsin State Fair engaged in bitter arguments with the local Nazi Party, the Nazis and the Zionist Organization of America both agreed to close their booths.

NEW YORK (WNS)--The well-known Jewish and pro-Israeli activities of Edgar Bronfman, No. Amer. Chairman of World Jewish Congress, are not believed to be the reason for the kidnaping of Bronfman's 21-year-old son, Samuel Bronfman, 2nd.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Rabbi Israel Miller, chairman of the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations, has accepted an invitation from the Rumanian government to visit Rumania.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- The Israeli government will officially boycott the United Nations conference on the prevention of crime with P.L.O. participating, in Geneva next month, but an Israeli professor has agreed to serve as rapporteur for the event.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The number of Israeli dissatisfied with President Ford has increased from 34.3 percent in June to 43.6 percent now, according to the Public Opinion Research Institute.

NEW YORK (LNS)--In an unscheduled public address at Lubavitcher world headquarters in New York, the Lubavitcher Rebbe, Rabbi Menachem M. Schneerson, called for unity amongst Jews throughout the world.

TEL AVIV (WNS) --Three persons were slightly hurt when a bomb exploded in a small synagogue in a Tel Aviv suburb.

JERUSALEM (WNS)--The Israeli Cabinet has announced that Israel will not participate in the United Nations conference on crime in Geneva because of the participation of a delegation from the Palestine Liberation Organization as observers.

NEW YORK (WNS)--Federal Judge Jack B. Weinstein of Brooklyn, who earlier this year sentenced Jewish Defense League founder Rabbi Meir Kahane to a year in prison, has ruled for the second time that Kahane has a constitutional right to kosher food while in prison.

NEW YORK (WNS)--Samuel Bronfman, 2nd, the 21-year-old son of world Jewish leader Edgar M. Bronfman, was freed eight days after he was kidnaped.

LONDON (WNS)--The police have warned they will not tolerate any demonstrations against the Palestine Liberation Organization when the Queen attends the opening of the Inter-Parliamentary Union conference at Westminster Hall next month.

JERUSALEM (WNS)---A 19-year-old Israeli woman soldier who associated with an Austrian officer stationed on the Golan Heights into Syrian territory faces a military tribunal.

JERUSALEM (WNS)--Israel will not be "the first state to introduce nuclear weapons into the Middle East conflict," Premier Yitzhak Rabin told Mexican reporters who accompanied Mexican President Luis Echeverria to Israel.

NEW YORK (WNS)--Isaac Gilyutin, a 36-year-old cyberneticist from Leningrad, was detained by Soviet authorities just as he, his wife, and daughter were about to board a plane on their way to Israel.
