And there aren't too many movie around today that can boast of that.

BOOK TRIPPING...Arlington House has come up with another winner for movie buffs and historians who need reference books. This time ROCHELLE LARKIN takes on Columbia Pictures and paints a pretty complete picture of the little studio off Gower Gulch that was considered to be the step child of the major studios and how HARRY COHN worked to push Columbia to the top. "Hail Columbia" covers all the Columbia films from the very first shorts to their first feature "More to Be Pitied than Scorned" to their Oscar winning film (It Happened One Night, "You Can't Take It With You" "All the King's Men", "From Here To Eternity," "The Bridge on the River Kwai," "On the Waterfront", "Lawrence of Arabia", "A Man for All Seasons" & "Oliver!") up to 1973. It's quite a story of accomplishment and Ms Larkin has made it sound just as interesting as it must have been. 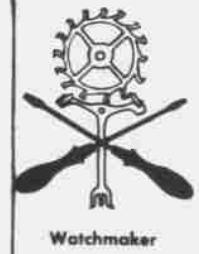
