"Country Music U.S.A." now in its seventh edition at the Landmark Hotel is comin' on strong with one powerful performer -- Henson Cargill -- who has returned for his second CMUSA show.

Cargill is a real cowboy (he raises buffalo and cattle side-by-side on his ranch outside Oklahoma City) as well as a "rhinestone cowboy" whose popularity is soaring, partially due to his dynamic performance in the Jubilee Room, and also by a great extent due to his latest Elektra recording "Dixie" -- a most timely contribution to America's Bicentennial. Also starring in the country musical revue are Grammy winners The Kimberlys, who received the coveted award for their rendition of


"McArthur Park." day, the talented young singers headlined at the Las Vegas Jaycee Fair.

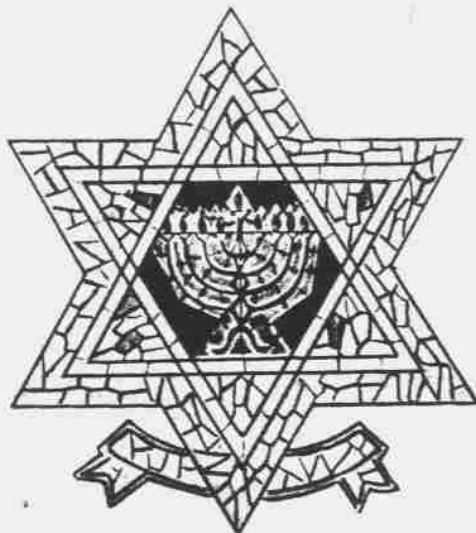
