The National Jewish Welfare Board does not concern itself with the kind of welfare we associate with doles or relief.

The welfare which gave this national organization its name was that of Jewish men in uniform. Back in World War I, the U.S. government wanted to deal with a representative Jewish group in re chaplains, the spiritual and gastronomic care of Jewish recruits, etc.

So the JWB came into being. Since that time the JWB has become the mother institution of Jewish Community Centers and YMHAs. One of the largest is still called the "92nd St. Y" on Lexington Avenue in Manhattan. JWB also houses the finest Jewish lecture bureau. It services Jewish camps and sponsors Jewish Book Month and Jewish Music Month and has a host of other important activities. Its chief

executive is Herbert Millman, a splendid administrator, as is his predecessor, Sanford Solender, who now is one of the chief executives of the combined New York UJA and Federation of Jewish Philanthropies.

On the JWB staff there are a cluster of talented individuals. One of them is Rabbi Phillip Goodman, who helps edit the best periodical about Jewish literature we have; it's called "In Jewish Bookland."

More than an editor and desk jockey, Rabbi Goodman is a scholar. He has specialized in producing books which contain data about our holidays. One of his books, done with his wife, Hannah, is a treasure trove of information about Jewish marriage.

Encyclopedic and charmingly printed, the list of Goodman opi includes the Rosh Hashanah Anthology, the Yom Kippur Anthology, the Purim Anthology, the Passover Anthology, and most recently the Shavuot Anthology.

From sermons to jests, from food to music, from fiction to source material, each of the

Goodman anthologies is a delight to read. They also make fine gift items for Bar Mitzvahs, confirmations, weddings and when you are someone's dinner guest. The Jewish community is indebted to the JWB and also to one of its stars, Rabbi Phillip Goodman.

VOLKSWAGEN STILL ON SALE IN ISRAEL

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith has labeled as "a typical Arab ploy" an announcement by the Arab Boycott Office that Volkswagen has been removed from the Arab blacklist because it has given "satisfactory" evidence of boycotting Israel.

According to ADL chairman Seymour

Graubard, Volkswagen is continuing to sell its cars in Israel. Graubard said Volkswagen, one of the largest car-selling agencies in Israel, never violated Arab boycott regulations which prohibits such things as partnerships, plants and patents in Israel, but not sales in that country of finished products manufactured outside.
