NEW YORK (WNS) -- Israeli Defense Minister Shimon Peres urged American leaders not to "go on vacation" in mobilizing support for Israel because of the Israeli - Egyptian agreement and the promises of broad United States military and economic assistance. Speaking at a meeting of the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations, Peres said the Sinai accord did not mean that the Middle East dangers were over but it did mean there was new hope for all peace-loving people. Peres said that Israel's request for American military

equipment was higher not because she was seeking more weapons but because the price of weapons had increased by 23 percent. He said Israel had asked for the "Pershing" missile "not to decide the outcome of a war but to deter war. If the Arabs know that we have the Pershing missiles, they might have second thoughts about launching a war." He said the controversy about the "Pershings" being able to carry nuclear warheads was false since Israel had other means of delivering warheads if it ever decided to do so.

CONFRONTATION OVER COMPANIES IN ARAB BOYCOTT

WASH. (WNS) -- Commerce Secretary Rogers Morton's refusal to reveal to a House committee the names of American companies involved in the Arab boycott appears certain to trigger a major confrontation between the Ford Administration and Congress over the issue. Morton told the House Commerce Committee's subcommittee on oversight and investigations that Attorney General Edward H. Levi had given him an opinion that the law barred disclosing

"propriety information" unless the national interest required it. His statement was in response to a question by Rep. John E. Moss (D. Calif) the subcommittee's chairman on why he had ignored the committee's subpoena for the reports made by the companies to the Commerce Department. The American Jewish Congress and the Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith have filed separate suits in federal courts seeking to force the Commerce Department to make the list of com-

panies complying with the Arab boycott public. They have accused Morton of seeking to protect the companies.
