MANDATE RENEWAL OCT. 24 TESTS SOVIET INTENT

-- The renewal of the UNEF mandate on mandate October 24 would be a test of Soviet intentions towards the progress to peace set in motion by the second interim Sinai accord, Premier Yitzhak Rabin told members of United Jewish rhe Appeal Study Mission. Rabin, who addressed the UJA leaders at their closing conference at the Knesset said Israel deduced public statefrom ments by Syrian lead-ers and also from "diplomatic chan-nels" that Syria "does not want negotiations with Israel." The Premier said Israel would continue to observe the Syrian disengagement on a reciprocal basis. He expressed hope that the date set for the next UNDOF renewal on the Golan Heights -- November 30 -- would be "over-come." If a "stabi-lization" could be achieved through the

"critical dates two -- October 24 and November 30 -- then the "positive" trends which had so far developed in the six weeks since the Sinai accord was signed could be exploited, hopefully, for further advance,

Rabin said. Referring to events in Lebanon, Rabin said it was "strange" that one world Christian leader had "said anything" about the fate of the more than one million Christians who were being threatened being threatened there. He expressed hope that Lebanon's integrity and status quo could be maintained and that the Lebanese would finally "overcome" their internal difficulties.




