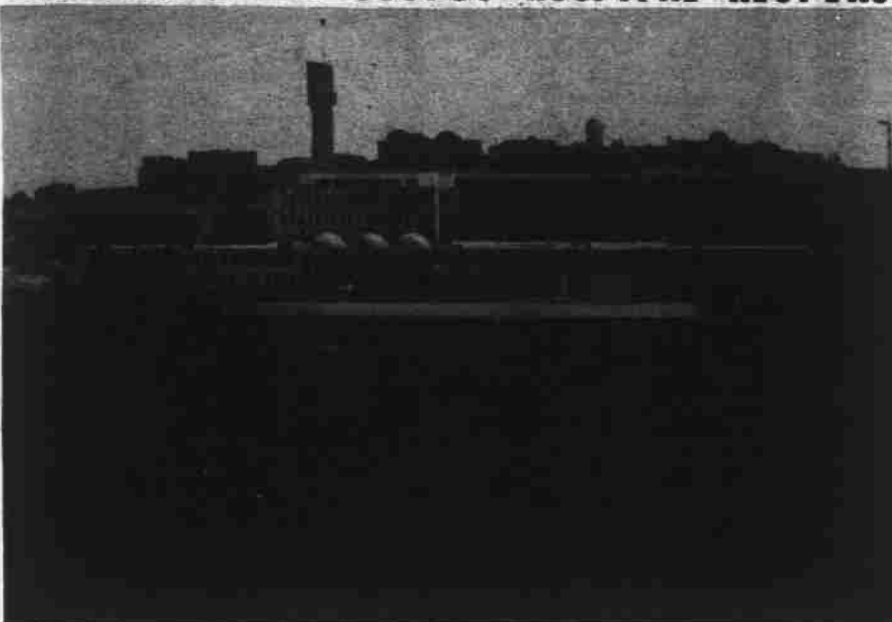


HADASSAH'S MT. SCOPUS HOSPITAL REOPENS



JERUSALEM...TUESDAY, OCTOBER 21, ONE OF THE MOST HISTORIC EVENTS IN HADASSAH'S 63-YEARS OF SERVICE WILL TAKE PLACE WHEN ITS HOSPITAL ON MOUNT SCOPUS IS REDEDICATED AFTER IT WAS FORCED TO EVACUATE IT BY THE JORDANIAN OCCUPATION IN 1948. OVER 3,000 DELEGATES AND GUESTS WILL ATTEND THE CEREMONY WHICH WILL BE ADDRESSED BY THE PRESIDENT AND PRIME MINISTER OF ISRAEL AND THE U.S. AMBASSADOR.

A drama starring 340,000 American women volunteers is being played out on the historic slopes of Mount Scopus in Jerusalem. Hadassah's magnificent hospital is being re-dedicated after having been dormant for 19 years.

Expanded to 3 1/2 times its original size at a cost of over \$35 million, the Hadassah University Hospital, Mount Scopus, will provide the most advanced community health and rehabilitation services available to all the people of Jerusalem and environs. This hospital is part of the Hadassah - Hebrew University Medical Center, whose main campus for healing, teaching and research is located at Ein Karem in West Jerusalem.

Originally opened in 1939, the Hadassah University Hospital, Mount Scopus was

the model medical facility of the Mid-east, and it was largely staffed by doctors who had fled the Nazi holocaust. In 1948, in Israel's War of Independence, access was cut off.

For 12 years, Hadassah and Hebrew University - Hadassah Medical School operated from five scattered old buildings in Jewish - held Jerusalem, until they moved into the new Hadassah-Hebrew University Medical Center in Ein Karem.

At this new medical center a major program providing medical, public health and technical training to developing countries was begun. It has been acclaimed by our own Congressional committees and the World Health Organization.

Then, in 1967, Mount Scopus was returned to Hadassah. Encouraged by a grant from the U.S.

Agency for International Development for the purchase of equipment in the United States, Hadassah undertook the massive renovation and expansion. Now, after eight long years -- including another war and a soaring inflation -- Mount Scopus is reborn as a hill of healing.

Caring for people of all faiths -- in good times and in bad -- in peace and war -- with one high standard for all, the Hadassah Medical Organization has had an international reputation for its medical and humanitarian work. The American women of Hadassah have made a contribution to peace and good will, of which all Americans should be proud.
