WASH. D. C. SADAT: "U.S. SHOULD ESTABLISH DIALOGUE WITH P.L.O. TO HELP PROMOTE PEACE IN MIDEAST."

NEW YORK: N.Y. CITY'S MAYOR ABE BEAME DENIED OFFICIAL WELCOME TO SADAT FOR SUPPORTING U.N. RESOLUTION EQUATING ZIONISM WITH RACISM.

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senator Hubert H. Humphrey introduced a resolution urging that the U.S. Senate "strongly" condemn the resolution adopted by the Third Committee of the United Nations General Assembly on October 17 equating Zionism with racism and racial discrimination, also the Humphrey resolution further urges that the United Nations General Assembly disapprove the Third Committee's resolution when it is presented for a vote before that body.

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- In keeping with the spirit of the tyranny of the majority, the 'mighty' Security Council found it expedient to elect Qaddafi's Libya to the Security Council for a two-year term replacing Iraq. Other non-permanent states elected for a similar term were Dahomey, Panama and Rumania. A fifth seat, earmarked for an Asian country, deadlocked the Assembly. Both India and Pakistan had sought the seat and six votes failed to break the impasse.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Israel's request for long-range Pershing missiles will be viewed "with some sympathy," according to defense secretary James R. Schlesinger.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The Ford Administration was assailed by Rep. Morris K. Udall (D. Ariz.) for "double think and double talk" at "the expense of Israel and our nation's principles." The U.S. is "clear in its firm economic as well as military commitments to Egypt," he said. "We are providing Saudi Arabia and Jordan with highly sophisticated weaponry which may be used against Israel." He called upon President Ford and Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger not to back away from U.S. commitments to Israel.

LONDON (WNS) -- Hugh Fraser, a Conservative member of Parliament and a life-long friend of Zionism narrowly escaped death when a bomb exploded under his car. His house guest, Caroline Kennedy, daughter of President John F. Kennedy, also escaped the bomb blast.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Chaim Herzog, Israel's Ambassador to the United Nations, has declared that his remarks that the reaction of American and world Jewry were an inadequate response to the anti-Zionism resolution adopted by the United Nations Social, Humanitarian and Cultural Committee was aimed at the Jewish man-in-the-street both in New York and in Israel and not at the American Jewish leadership.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- President Ford in a formal statement said that the United States deploras "in the strongest terms the recent vote in the United Nations Social Committee characterizing Zionism as a form of racism."

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Eight persons were slightly injured when a booby-trapped car exploded outside a hotel in downtown Jerusalem.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Former Premier Golda Meir, speaking by telephone to Prof. Benjamin Levitch, the Soviet Jewish scientist who has been seeking an exit visa since 1972, told him "you are not forgotten, we shall do everything to help you come here."

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- David Elazar told a group of military experts meeting here that his recommendation for a pre-emptive strike against Egypt and Syria on the eve of the Yom Kippur War was overruled by the then Premier Golda Meir because of political considerations.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- A wildcat strike of workshop employees that has grounded El Al for over a week was criticized by Premier Yitzhak Rabin.

SADAT WILL ABIDE BY SINAI ACCORD

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- "Will Egypt honor the terms of the Sinai accord?"

Thus queries UN correspondent Richard Yaffe in a lengthy appraisal of the pro and cons of the Sinai Agreement appearing in the current issue of Israel Horizons which he also edits.

"Our belief is that it will be kept," Yaffe holds, "provided there is a definite movement towards an overall settlement between Israel and the other states with whom she has been at war, i.e. Syria and Jordan."

Another reason why Sadat will not wish to become involved in another war with Israel lies in the fact that he has made a complete break with the Soviet Union whom he has blamed for Syria's intransigence.

Mr. Yaffe himself makes this fact quite clear when he points out in the opening of his appraisal that the Sinai accord represents for Sadat "a stunning vindication of his decision of two years ago to cut loose from Russia and hitch Egypt's wagon to 'my friend Henry's' star, reversing an anti-American policy of fifteen years' standing and dealing a bad blow to Russia's aims in the Middle East."

"If Israel needs peace...so does Sadat, perhaps even more so, for he has problems even greater than Israel's which are

great enough," Yaffe emphasizes. "He has a population more than ten times greater than Israel's, with most of his people hungry, or nearly so, and too many people living in shanty towns..."
