

CHRISTIAN LEADER CONDEMNS SADAT TALK

NEW YORK -- "We should not be surprised that Sadat of Egypt, the former Nazi agent, presumes to define the Jewish people and the Jewish experience. Nor should we be surprised at the official Anti-Semitism of so many governments in the United Nations," said Dr. Franklin H. Littell, professor of Religion at Temple University in Philadelphia, PA and chairman of Christians Concerned for Israel at the 35th Anniversary Luncheon of the Jewish Reconstructionist Foundation on Sunday, November 2nd at the Hotel Pierre in New York City.

Contending that Sadat, in his recent

comments before the National Press Club, was using the "old semantic trick" of playing word games about racial "semites." Professor Littell said that "Anti-Semitism is in fact rife in the Muslim world -- from the official publication and distribution of hundreds of thousands of copies of The Protocols of the Elders of Zion to the murderous acts and utterances of a General Amin of Uganda."

U.N. Milestone

The Jewish world basked in the reflected glory, to essay a cliché, of Rabbi Robert Gordis who was the spokesman for Judaism at a notable seminar held in the United Nations on the occasion of the 30th anniversary of the founding of that body.

At a convocation under the auspices of the Temple of Understanding, an ecumenical enterprise founded by Mrs. Dickerman Hollister, of Greenwich, Conn., five representatives of some of the world's religions, spoke.

Dr. Gordis, eloquent and erudite, drove home the fact that the seminar slogan, "One Is The Human Spirit," is what Judaism has been trying to teach the world from the days of Avraham. The Temple of Understanding also staged a week-long series of programs at the Cathedral of St. John the Divine in New York City. One of the speakers, Rabbi Herbert Weiner, author and orator, excoriated the UN for its recent shenanigans involving the Ugandan admirer of Hitler and the unspeakably libellous resolution equating racism and Zionism.
