

### SANTINI SPONSORS CONDEMNATION OF UN DRAFT

A house resolution condemning the United Nations' Committee effort to equate "zionism" with "racism" is co-sponsored by Congressman Jim Santini. Santini, who also objected to an earlier effort to expel Israel from the United Nations, said the latest attempt amounts to a "smear campaign against Jewish nationalism by some Third World countries." The United Nations' Third World Committee recently approved, 70-28, a measure terming zionism as a "form

of racism and racial discrimination." The results must still be confirmed by the U.N. General Assembly.

The resolution in the House, co-sponsored by all but five Representatives, urges the General Assembly to disapprove the Committee's action.

"The United Nations, under the guise of a program to eliminate racism, is at the point of officially endorsing anti-semitism, one of the oldest and most virulent forms of racism known to human history,"

reads the resolution. "I am displeased that Israel has become the first U.N. member to have its doctrine of nationalism and its movement of national liberation defamed by brother states," added Santini.
