met with Daniel Moynihan, the U.S. Ambassador to the UN, to denounce the resolution, noting that the day the anti-Zionist draft is adopted "will live in history as a day of infamy." George Meany, AFL-CIO leader had earlier declared that if the resolution is adopted it will result in "massive alienation of American support" for the UN. He said the ultimate object of the resolution is the "expulsion of Israel from the UN."

Sixty American Catholic and Protestant church leaders, attending the second National Christian - Jewish Relations Workshop in Memphis, Tennessee, issued a declaration urging the General Assembly to reject the resolution because "It is a slander against Jews everywhere, since it is a revival of the all too familiar anti-Semitism which has plagued mankind through the centuries."

**PLO RIPS ZIONISM, U.S. AT U.N.**

**UNITED NATIONS** (WNS) -- The General Assembly began its annual debate on the Palestine question with a call from Farouk Kaddouni, head of the Palestine Liberation Organization delegation, for it to take "effective and operational measures" to eliminate Zionism and the State of Israel.

Denouncing "the Zionist enemy and its imperialist ally the United States," Kaddouni reiterated the PLO's demand for the establishment of a secular, democratic state in all of Palestine, denounced a step-by-step approach to the Middle East settlement as doomed to failure and indicated that the PLO would not be a party to the Geneva peace conference as long as it was based on United Nations resolutions that ignored the rights of Palestinians.

Israeli Ambassador Chaim Herzog, who

followed Kaddouni to the rostrum, said every word in the PLO proposals is designed to block any move "which would envisage an overall solution to the problems of the Middle East based on compromise and mutual recognition." Noting the General Assembly's built-in majority against Israel, Herzog observed that at least 30 percent of the Assembly's time is devoted to vilifying Israel. "This Assembly will live in infamy," he said, because while Lebanon is bleeding to death, the General Assembly is becoming "an instrument of political warfare against Israel." Meanwhile Egypt introduced a resolution under which the General Assembly would confer on the PLO the right to full participation as an equal partner in the Geneva conference. **ISRAEL IS KEYSTONE TO U.S. POLICY**

**WASH. (WN) --** The "Keystone" of American policy in the Middle East "has always rested on the ability of Israel to persevere in its own defense," Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger told the House International Relations Committee.

Arguing for the Administration's proposal to provide Israel with \$2.24 billion in economic and military aid, Kissinger said this program "is aimed at permitting both defensive strength and economic health. Our new friendship for Egypt does not in any way undermine our traditional friendship for Israel."

Kissinger said the U.S. should also nurture its growing friendship with Egypt by helping it solve its economic problems and encouraging its "efforts toward closer rela-

ing his visit to the United States urged the U.S. to include the Palestinians in the Geneva negotiations.

But when President Ford was asked about this at a news conference with Florida television reporters, he said the Palestinians "have refused to recognize the State of Israel in its attitude that there must be recognition before there can be any contacts or any participation by the Palestinians in any negotiations."

**LEGISLATION AGAINST ARAB BOYCOTT**

**WASH. (WNS) --** A bill that would immediately make public attempts by Arab governments to have American firms comply with the Arab boycott has been approved by the Senate Banking and Currency Committee's subcommittee on international finance and now goes to the full committee for action.

Under the legislation introduced by Sen. Adlai Stevenson (D.Ill.) the subcommittee's chairman, and Sen. Harrison Williams (D.N.J.) the penalties that may be imposed on American com-

panies that violate the anti-boycott regulations are increased from \$1,000 to \$10,000. The new legislation would require the Department of Commerce to make the company reports public and American firms would have to indicate if they intend to comply with the Arab boycott demands. The bill would also make it illegal for an American company to disclose to a boycotting country any information regarding the race, religion or origin of an employee, director or shareholder or officer and, in addition, would make it illegal for a company to provide such information to any other American firm.
