DETAILS OF INFAMOUS RESOLUTION PASSED BY DESPOTS AND RACISTS

ADMINISTRATION-CONGRESS CONFLICT

WASH. (WNS) -- A White House spokesman said that President Ford deplored the anti-Zionist resolution adopted by the United Nations General Assembly.

White House Press Secretary William Greener said that Ford considers the Assembly action "wholly unjustified" and reaffirms "his belief that adoption of the resolution undermines the principles on which the UN is based." But Greener said he did not know if Ford planned any concrete action to show his displeasure although he replied "no" when asked if the U.S. contemplated leaving the U.N.

Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger, calling the resolution an "emotion of the day," said the U.S.

had no intention of taking economic reprisals against the countries that voted for the resolution equating Zionism with racism.

However, the Administration's refusal to retaliate may put it in conflict with Congress. Several Senators have suggested that the U.S. cut off foreign aid funds to countries that voted for the resolution. The Senate and House have adopted resolutions to review the U. S. relationship to the UN.

Meanwhile, Gaston Thorn, President of the UN General Assembly, after talks with President Ford and Kissinger said he was pleased that the U.S. will not attempt to retaliate against the UN by economic or other means.

UNITED NATIONS (WNS) -- In a day-long session of anti-Israeli activities, the General Assembly adopted a resolution which termed Zionism as "a form of racism and racial discrimination" and two other resolutions which supported the Palestine Liberation Organization.

The anti-Zionist resolution which had been approved by the General Assembly's Third Committee was adopted by the Assembly by a vote of 72-35 with 32 abstentions. The vote came after the Assembly defeated a motion by Belgium to postpone action until next year.

Israel's Ambassador to the United Nations, Chaim Herzog, in a speech just before the vote, declared that it was "symbolic" that the anti-Zionist resolution was being adopted on November 10, the same date as Kristallnacht in 1938 "when Hitler's Nazi Storm Troopers launched a coordinated attack on the Jewish community in Germany.. It was the night which led to the most terrifying holocaust in the history of man." Herzog concluded his speech which traced the history of Zionism by angrily tearing up the resolution after declaring that "for us, the Jewish people, this resolution based on hatred, falsehood and arrogance, is devoid of any legal value. For us, the Jewish people, this is no more than a piece of paper and we shall treat it as such." Herzog also stressed to the Assembly's delegates that he was not talking as a "suppliant." He said the "issue is not Israel or Zionism. The issue is the con-

Zionism is Judaism

THE ZIONIST ORGANIZATION OF AMERICA IS EMBARKING UPON A NATIONWIDE CAMPAIGN OF A MASS DISTRIBUTION OF LAPEL BUTTONS, CARRYING THE INSCRIPTION ZIONISM IS A BADGE OF HONOR.

Cantor Joe Kohn hit the nail on the head at Temple Beth Shalom's Services last Friday, when he spoke words to the effect that it is not enough for a Jew to just be a Zionist, we must shout it out for all the world to know.

What happened when the Arab-Afro-Russian bloc at the U.N. passed the despicable anti-Zionist resolution, was a direct challenge to every Jew to come forward in clear-cut, unmistakable language that he (or she) is totally and unequivocally Zionist for the existence, survival and growth of the State of Israel. Nothing less will suffice. The world must be told that Judaism and Zionism are one and the same.

Being a Zionist is no reflection on an American Jew being a loyal patriotic American. "Zionism," Israeli Ambassador Chaim Herzog told the General Assembly of the U.N. "is nothing more, nothing less than the Jewish people's sense of origin and destination in the land linked eternally with its name."

Egypt's President Anwar Sadat is attempting to create a distinction between Jews and Zionists. It will fall flat on its face, when the Jews rise to the occasion. To justify the abominable lie passed by the U.N. that Zionism is equated with racism, Sadat said "Arabs have nothing against Jews. Its Zionists we want to oust from the Mideast." He added: "Some of my best friends are Jews." (Where have we heard that before?)

The dictionary defines Zionism: "Among modern Jews, a movement for colonizing in Israel, for religious or nationalizing purposes." It is the fulfillment of a 2000 year hope for a homeland for Jews, who desire to go there. It is the center for Hebrew government, worship, and national life. We would equate it, to some extent generally with the Vatican or Salt Lake City.

Now to defuse the big lie resolved by the U.N. that Zionism is equated with racism, a term, which even in its most remote connotation cannot in any manner, shape or form be associated with the history of the Jews, Nazism was racism.

The dictionary says a racist has the assumption of racial superiority and consequently discriminates against other races with hatred.
