NEW YORK -- Director General of Youth Aliyah in Israel, Shraga Adiel, has just com-pleted a tour of North and South America in order to provote the programs of Youth Aliyah in Israel as well as to become acquainted with Jewish education in these continents.

WASHINGTON -- The American Jewish Committee urged Congress to appropriate the full sums asked by the Ford Administration for help to Israel and Egypt as a "prudent investment in peace and in the best national interests of the United States."

PHILADELPHIA -- The Honorable Yisrael Yeshayahu, Speaker of the Knesset (Congress) in Israel, will be awarded an honorary degree of Doctor of Humane Letters by The Dropsie University at a special convocation November

NEW YORK -- Four Sisterhoods in South Africa and one in Puerto Rico are part of a group of II new affiliates that have joined the National Federation of Temple Sisterhoods, the women's agency of Reform Judaism.
