

SUGGESTIONS FOR HOLIDAY MEAL

The Holiday Season each year brings family, friends, and food together. For these occasions, to have a happy outcome it is important to observe historic safeguards if one prepares a turkey or other large fowl.

It is better to thaw poultry at refrigerator temperatures than at room temperature, even though this may take a day or two.

It is better to prepare and cook stuffing before placing it in the fowl than to use an uncooked stuffing mixture.

After serving, refrigerate the remaining turkey promptly rather than letting it stand for hours at room temperature.

Finally, when preparing left overs, heat portions completely before serving.
