

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

SACRAMENTO (WNS) -- Jews, Blacks and women will be excluded from a plan to send as many as 500 un-to-be unemployed California State Transportation Department engineers to build roads in Saudi Arabia.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Daniel J. Boorstein, a Pulitzer Prize-winning historian and educator of Russian Jewish parentage, has been sworn in as the 12th Librarian of Congress.

TORONTO (WNS) -- The Canadian government has issued a ministerial permit to Shafik al Hour, vice-chairman of the Palestine Liberation Organization delegation to the United Nations to come to Canada for a series of lectures on "How Can Zionism Be a Form of Racism?"

RAS SADAR, SINAI (WNS) -- Some 48 hours after Israeli soldiers withdrew from this town on the southwest Sinai coast, Egyptian civilian authorities took over administration of Ras Sudar which is surrounded by oilfields. The area is the first evacuated by Israel under the term of the Sinai agreement with Egypt.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The police have set up a mobile police station in Zion Square in the wake of a bomb-blast that killed six Israeli teenagers.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Despite the anti-Zionist resolution adopted by the United Nations General Assembly, the Ford Administration is opposed to any cuts in the \$1.3 billion it has requested in aid for Egypt, Syria and Jordan.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Ending a two-day visit to Israel, U.S. Secretary of Agriculture Earl Butz praised Israel's achievements in agriculture.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Israel will demand full compensation for the property left behind by Jews from Arab countries when they were forced to emigrate after the establishment of the State of Israel, the Knesset Foreign Affairs and Defense Committee declared.

LONDON (WNS) -- The World Federation of Polish Jews has protested to the Polish government over plans to demolish the last remaining part of the Warsaw Ghetto.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The Greater New York Conference on Soviet Jewry reports that Aleksandr Silnitsky, 23, of Krasnodar has been sentenced to three years for "draft evasion" after months of harassment by Soviet authorities.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Jews and non-Jews concerned with the welfare of Rumania's Jewish Community should not make the question of aliya from Rumania a public issue, Rabbi Moses Rosen, the Chief Rabbi of Rumania, warned here.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- The House Subcommittee on Oversight and Investigations voted 10-5 to hold Commerce Secretary Rogers Morton in contempt of Congress for refusing to provide it with documents on American companies who have complied with Arab boycott demands.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- One thousand young American Jewish leaders, members of the Koach Mission, the largest United Jewish Appeal Mission ever to come to Israel, marched through the streets of Jerusalem, carrying banners listing their home cities and signs proclaiming "I am a Zionist."

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The Jewish National Fund has announced the three winners of its annual Menahem Ussishkin Award named after the late Zionist leader. They will be given to Dr. Alex Bein, the biographer of Theodor Herzl and author of several books on the history of settlements in Eretz Yisrael; Dalia Rabikowitz, for a recent book of poems, and the late writer Shlomo Grodzinski.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- "If Israel collapses because of the armaments supplied (to the Arabs) by the Soviet Union, it would have the profoundest consequences for democracy in the U.S. and other parts of the world," Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger told the Senate Foreign Affairs Committee's subcommittee on security assistance.
