AMER. JEWISH COMM. ASKS US TO REASSESS U.N. SUPPORT

NEW YORK -- Responding to the vote in the U.N. General Assembly in favor of a resolution equating Zionism with racism, the American Jewish Committee has urged the United States Government to "re-assess its support of the United Nations, and consider possible counter-measures such as selective participation in the United Nations General Assembly and selective funding of

United Nations projects." In an official statement, Elmer L. Winter, AJC National President, termed the

resolution "the most shameful of all the anti-Israel resolutions adopted by U.N. bodies and committees to date."
