

ISRAEL'S MISSION SNUBS JEWISH NEWSMEN

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- This correspondent, who has always had the highest praise for the dynamism displayed and the courageous stand taken by the Israeli diplomats here at the UN vis-a-vis the known enemies of the Jewish State, is prompted this week to report on one shortcoming -- attributed not to the diplomats themselves but those handling public relations.

It has been generally known that Israel has fallen short on this one issue so vital for the Israeli cause abroad.

Far be from this writer to criticize Israel, but self-criticism now and then might well serve our common struggle well. Ambassador Chaim Herzog himself, in his excellent book, "The War of Atonement," did not hesitate to score some of the Israelis responsible for shortcomings on the eve of the Yom Kippur War.

Here at the UN recently eyebrows were being raised at certain tactics apparently adopted by those in charge of public relations

for the Israeli Mission towards Jewish correspondents whose position relative to the Jewish State is taken for granted

Press briefings at the UN are normally conducted by other Missions for all correspondents. However, of late most of the Israeli briefings have been split up. Correspondents representing non-Jewish media are given preference and special attention by being invited first and only later, in a follow-up briefing, Jewish and Israeli newsmen are invited, most of whom

feel not only embarrassed but also somehow let down. One or two have even used the term "discrimination."

It is high time, in the view of this writer that those in charge of Israel's public relations here, approach all correspondents on an equal footing and not give preference to certain press and radio media in the belief that they represent more important outlets. In the long run, such a policy may prove detrimental to the great cause we all espouse.

ISRAELI PRESS SPOKESMAN REPLIES

By David Horowitz UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- An Israeli Mission press spokesman, disturbed over this writer's recent 'self-criticism' report with respect to what your correspondent believed to be a differentiation which the Mission's press officers had made in the arrangement of press briefings with Jewish and non-Jewish reporters, this week rebutted the criticism with a definitive denial that non-Jewish media "had been given preference and special

attention." "You can rest assured," the spokesman stated, "that Ambassador Chaim Herzog is well aware, as we all are, of the vital importance of the Jewish publications and of the Jewish media in general in this country and everywhere else..."

This writer, in his report, had referred to "a gala luncheon arranged for Foreign Minister Yigal Allon...at which," he stated, "a fine comb was used to pick a group that had omit-

ted well-known and seasoned Jewish journalists..."

To this the spokesman noted that "the participants at the luncheon given by Ambassador Chaim Herzog in honor of H. E. Yigal Allon were not chosen according to their religious affiliations..."

This amiable and friendly Israeli spokesman can now unburden the double duty placed upon him because of the understaffing. Tuvia Saar, a newcomer here, has been appointed press information officer.
