UN MANDATE RENEWED BUT ISRAEL NIXES ANY RESOLUTION CHANGES

US LETS ISRAEL DOWN

UNITED NATIONS (UNS) -- THE SECURITY COUNCIL BY A 13-0 VOTE RENEWED THE MANDATE FOR THE UNITED NATIONS DIS-ENGAGEMENT OBSERVER FORCE FOR ANOTHER SIX MONTHS WITH A RESOLUTION THAT PAVED THE WAY FOR THE PARTICIPATION OF THE PALESTINE LIBERATION ORGANIZATION AT A COUNCIL DEBATE ON THE MIDDLE EAST TO BE HELD IN JANUARY. THE RESOLUTION DID NOT NAME THE PLO BUT SAID THAT THE COUNCIL WILL RE-CONVENE IN JANUARY "TO CONTINUE THE DEBATE ON THE MIDDLE EAST PROBLEM, INCLUDING THE PALESTINIAN QUESTION, TAKING INTO ACCOUNT ALL RELEVANT UNITED NATIONS RESOLUTIONS." HOWEVER, SOVIET AMBASSADOR YAKOV A. MALIK, THE COUNCIL'S PRESIDENT, SAID IT WAS THE "UNDERSTANDING" OF A MAJORITY OF THE COUNCIL THAT THE PLO WOULD BE INVITED TO THE MIDEAST DEBATE. THE U.S., WHICH HAD SAID IT WOULD USE ITS VETO TO BLOCK PLO PARTICIPATION WENT ALONG WITH THE COMPROMISE RESOLUTION REPORTEDLY ON INSTRUCTIONS FROM PRESIDENT FORD AND SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY A. KISSINGER BY RADIO FROM THE PRESIDENTIAL PLANE WHICH WAS ON THE WAY TO CHINA. ISRAELI AMBASSADOR CHAIM HERZOG ANGRILY CALLED THE SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION "A SURRENDER TO SYRIAN BLACKMAIL AND SOVIET DICTATES." U.S. AMBASSADOR DANIEL MOYNIHAN SAID THE U.S. RULED OUT ANY TRANSFER OF THE MIDEAST NEGOTIATIONS TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL AND THAT THE U.S. WENT ALONG WITH THE RESOLUTION OUT OF DEFERENCE FOR THE COUNCIL'S RIGHT TO DISCUSS THE ISSUE, BUT IN ISRAEL THERE WAS A WIDESPREAD FEELING THAT

MORE MOROCCON JEWS THAN OTHERS

NEW YORK (WUP) -- Morocco tops the list of the number of Jews remaining in Arab countries, according to an item

appearing in World Over, the national magazine for Young People.

Some 35,000 Jews reside in King Hassan's domain as against a mere 1,000 in Algeria, 2,000 in Lebanon; 600 in Yemen; 4,500 in Syria; 400 in Iraq; 400 in Egypt, and 20 in Libya.

Of the 800,000 Jews who lived in these states when Israel was established in 1948, only 53,000 remain. Most of them are small merchants and artisans. In Syria and Iraq Jews are terrorized and refused permission to leave. In the other Arab countries the conditions are better, and Jews are even allowed to emigrate if they leave behind all of their money and possessions.

Some Moroccan Jews are engaged in the sardine industry.

When the hell are we going to get an administration that will stop all this nonsense about detente and appeasement and start protecting the rights and interests of the American public? Israel is being ripped off, a step at a time. Coming from every direction, and each time it is the American public that is the loser. One abominable scheme after another pops up and each time the Ford-Kissinger combine says go along, stay cool, don't worry, it's all in the name of peace. If peace means giving in to every trick and whim, then screw peace and let's call their bluff and be ready for the worst.

Israel wants peace more than any country in the world, crying for it, pleading for it. But that valiant little country, on its own, will back up to no one and will fight at the drop of a hat if its domination is violated.

The deal was made between UN Secretary General Kurt Waldheim and Syrian President Hafeg Assad. The U.S. could have vetoed it at this stage BUT FORD WENT ALONG with the compromise resolution. True, the administration vowed to veto PLO participation, but that remains to be seen.

Ford and Kissinger are pulling a Chamberlain at Munich. They must know, and we are going to shout it out on every opportunity, that each strengthening of the Soviet/Arab combine is a weakening of the U.S. stand. It's like when we sold the moth-ball tanker fleet and the dismantled N.Y.C. elevated railroad, as scrap to Japan a couple of years before Pearl Harbor. We got that scrap back in the form of shrapnel that meant dead and wounded American boys.
