

**MANDATE RENEWED**

THE U.S. HAS LET JERUSALEM DOWN. EMERGENCY CABINET AND KNESSET MEETINGS WERE SCHEDULED.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Premier Yitzhak Rabin has warned that any change in Security Council Resolutions 242 and 338 or in the letters of invitation to the Geneva peace conference on the Middle East would automatically release Israel from all its obligations under these resolutions.

The Security Council resolutions provide the framework for the Geneva conference and for the 1974 disengagement agreements on the Syrian and Egyptian fronts. Rabin's warning was made at the annual Palestine Partition Day luncheon given by local editor and the Foreign Press Association and was aimed at Syria's attempt to condition the renewal of the mandate for the United Nations Disengagement Observer Force (UNDOF) on the Golan Heights on the inclusion of the Palestine Liberation Organization in any peace talks.

Rabin repeated Israel's unqualified refusal to deal with the PLO under any circumstances and reiterated Israel's position that the Palestinian question can be dealt with only in the framework of peace negotiations with Jordan. Rabin said flatly that Israel had no interest in any deal which UN Secretary General Kurt Waldheim may have made with Syrian President Hafez Assad. He said Israel, which agrees to a six-month extension of UNDOF, would be prepared to attend a reconvened Mideast peace conference after Syria agrees to a similar extension without conditions. Rabin charged that the introduction by Damascus of the Palestinian issue into the UNDOF matter was part of a Soviet-Syrian interim accord signed last September.

At the United Nations, Chaim Herzog, Israel's Ambassador, sent information to the ambassadors of the seven Security Council members with which Israel has diplomatic relations -- the U.S., Britain, France, Japan, Sweden, Italy and Costa Rica -- pointing out that the renewal of UNDOF "is an integral part of the disengagement agreement signed by Israel and Syria, and cannot be made conditional to any other matter." Herzog also stressed that the original participants of the Geneva conference are the only ones who can decide what other participants should be included.

After returning from Syria, Waldheim reported to the Council that Syria agreed in principle to a six-month extension of UNDOF provided that the Council's resolution includes "a specific provision that the Council will reconvene in January 1976, for a substantive debate on the Middle East problem including the Palestinian question with the participation of the Palestine Liberation Organization." Such a provision would in effect alter Resolution 242 which contains no reference to the Palestinian issue.

**26 ETHNIC, MINORITY LEADERS PROTEST RESOLUTION**

CHICAGO -- Twenty-six leaders of national ethnic and minority organizations, at their own "United Nations Assembly" recently in Chicago, joined in a major rally to protest the anti-Zionism resolution adopted recently by the United Nations.

According to a joint statement that the leaders presented to the rally, which was organized by the Public Affairs Committee of the Jewish United Fund of Chicago, "the recent anti-Zionism resolution adopted by the United Nations denies to the Jewish people the same right of self-determination that is accorded to other peoples."

The statement, read to almost 10,000 persons at the rally held in Chicago's Civic Center by Thaddeus L. Kowalski, President of the Polish American Congress of Illinois, also stated: "To equate Zionism, a humanitarian movement, with racism is both a blatant lie and an insult to millions of Americans whose ethnic and racial backgrounds

make them sensitive to all forms of bigotry."

Mr. Kowalski also brought greetings and a strongly worded statement of support

from Aloysius A. Mazewski, National President of the Polish American Congress and a U.S. delegate to the United Nations.

BUENOS AIRES (WNS) -- A three-day celebration in the town of Mosessville in Sante Fe Province marked the centennial of the law enabling 130 Jewish families from Russia to found this town under the auspices of Baron Maurice de Hirsch's Jewish Colonization Association.

LOS ANGELES -- The Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith, which led the fight against the Caltrans - Saudi Arabia contract, commended Governor Edmund G. Brown, Jr., following his announcement that negotiations with that Middle East country were terminated by the State of California.
