Moynihan Needed at UN

The expressions of "strong support" by President Ford and Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger "for the effective job" being done by Daniel P. Moynihan as the United States Ambassador to the United Nations came not a minute too soon.

The outspoken Moynihan was rumored about to resign because of a lack of support from the American foreign policy establishment. Moynihan was recently severely castigated by British Ambassador Ivor Richard, an attack that was believed to have the support of some people in the State Department.

But Moynihan's resignation could have had disastrous results for American policy, especially in the Middle East. It would have been seen as a softening of the American stand against the resolution branding Zionism as racist and against the pro-Palestine Liberation Organization resolutions both of which were adopted by the UN General Assembly.

UN General Assembly. Moynihan has been criticized for "undiplomatic" language in the UN. But neither the Communist bloc nor the Arab nations have ever been noted for diplomatic niceties.

The American Ambassador has been saying some things that needed saying. Who can fault him for calling Uganda's Idi Amin a "racist murderer?" While he may have overdone it by including the Organization of African Unity in his attack, it is certainly ludicrous that this can be used by some African countries as their reason for voting in favor of the anti-Zionist resolution.

Israeli leaders have long argued that the attack on Israel is the first step of an attack on the West itself. Moynihan has said that the democratic countries are under attack and has defended Israel as an island of democracy in a sea of despotism.

If Moynihan's outspoken approach at the UN is heard by the Third World countries they must stop allowing themselves to be used for propaganda and begin to deal with their real problems.

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- On the verge of resigning from his UN post due to the fact that some State Department officials under Kissinger's prodding had threatened to muzzle his voice here at the UN, Daniel Patrick Moynihan was hastily summoned to the White House by President Ford last week for a face to face talk during which the courageous U.S. spokesman spoke out his mind in a confrontation that must have shaken the President to the realization that a loss of the most popular man in America today would have erupted into a sort of a revolution in the Administration.

not present for the whole meeting should reveal something. It revealed what most observers had sumised from the very beginning, namely, that differences had arisen between the two men, that Kissinger was responsible for Moynihan's threat to resign. For Kissinger, the super-super 'compromiser' that he is in his attempts to be a 'good guy' with everyone, the good and the bad, Moynihan had been too direct and outspoken vis-a-vis the 'bad' here at the UN - - the Arabs, the Soviets and most of the third world states - - and that for our Jewish State Department chief was not 'diplomatic' enough to his liking.

matic' enough to his tiking. To prevent another shake-up in his Administration - - especially on the eve of an election year and following so soon after the firing of Schlesinger, etc. - - President Ford 'convinced' Moynihan to remain in his post on his, Moynihan's terms, as became clear from press secretary Ron Nessen's statement made directly after the confrontation confab. "The President," he said "wants it clearly understood that Ambassador Moynihan has his complete confidence. The President and Secretary Kissinger encouraged Ambassador Moynihan to continue to speak out candidly and forcefully on major issues coming before the United Nations,"

Thus, the most courageous Ambassador Washington has ever accredited to this 'Reform School' returned to his postever so much stronger and vindicated of the bold stand he had taken vis-a-vis 1.rael's enemies who, throughout this 30th session, have felt the sting of his sharp, outspoken tongue.

It was Moynihan's criticism of Uganda's Idi Amin as a "racist murderer" and, indirectly, of the Organization of African Unity (OAU) states which Amin heads, but more especially of his fighting speeches in the Third Committee and in the General Assembly, which had adopted resolutions equating Zionism with racism, that had disturbed the State Department.


On the other hand, it was this bold stance that he had taken which won him national popularity and high praise voiced by the media in general and by the public in particular.

Moynihan's speech delivered in the General Assembly on November 10 -- a day that he said "will live in infamy" -- will undoubtedly be recorded in the annals of history as a document of the greatest historic significance in that it charged the United Nations with reenacting the Nazi scenario which witnessed mankind's worst holocaust that decimated one third of the Jewish people.

people, "The General Assembly" he declared after the anti-Semitic vote was adopted, "today grants symbolic amnesty, and more, to the murderers of the six million Jews...The proposition to be sanctioned by a resolution of the Assembly is that 'Zionism is a form of racism and racial discrimination," Now that is a lie, but it is a lie which the UN has declared to be a truth, and so the actual truth must be restated."

Pointing to the fact that the UN has never defined the term "racism", Moyniham repeated his charge: "What we have here is a lie, a political lie of a variety well known to the 20th century, and scarcely exceeded in all that annal (Continued on Page 5)

The next scam was the Arab/Russian/Afro majority voting Israel out of UNESCO, claiming Israeli archaelogists are ruining holy his-toric sights in the Mideast. This outrageous happening still stands although the world knows the Jews brought nothing but culture, exploration, education and progress to a centuries-old desert waste. It was the Arabs, prior to the 6-Day War in 1967, who devastated Jewish holy lands, using slabs of the Wailing Wall for floor ing in toilets. It was the Arabs who demolished the Hadassah Hospital in Jerusalem. Instead of utilizing its facilities, one of the finest medical institutions in the world was laid to waste. Moynihan was summoned to Washington and was about to resign, before, as he expected, to be fired. But Ford and Kissinger backed off, for the moment. Then Ford released a glowing statement of confidence in Moynihan, which, in politics, is tantamount to the rise before the fall.

Let's not kid ourselves. Russia creates hostility and is the chief source for unrest in the world. Using the Arabs as foils and Israel as the pawn, the Soviets will keep pecking away until the time comes ripe for them to use any incident as a cause for war. That's what the Chinese are telling Ford at this very moment.

We are not suggesting open warfare with Russia, far from it. What we are promulgating, and will continue as long as we have a public outlet, is alerting the American public to the ultimate, ugly goal of the Soviets.

Honest detent on our part makes us the laughing stock of the nations of the world. How can you expect conformation from the Russians who signed a resolution at Helsinki respecting human rights? This brazenly is being violated since the moment it was agreed. They not only stepped up persecution against the Soviet Jews, they also refuse to allow a Nobel Prize winner to leave Russia to accept the award. Don't you think it's about time we put our
