

# CHANUKAH LIGHTS ANSWER UN

"The celebration of Chanukah this year is striking a very responsive chord in the hearts of Jews all over the world," said Esther R. Landa, National President of the National Council of Jewish Women. "As we light the candles to celebrate the rescue of Judaism from destruction, in the year 168 B.C.E., our thoughts turn inevitably to current threats to our people in the year 5736."

"What are we to make of the recent UN resolution linking Zionism and racism, which so cruelly distorts the reality of Jewish and Israeli history? How are we to approach the irony of the Third World and Communist nations -- themselves suppressors of religious and political liberty -- joining to discredit us?" Mrs. Landa asked.

"We in Council believe that we can find the answer in kindling the lights, which remind us of past crises and past miracles," said the President. "As we light each candle, we should rekindle our own faith and determination. A candle for our faith, a candle for our belief in freedom for others, a candle for our own self-determination until eight candles burn very brightly for the future of the world."

Mrs. Landa has just returned from a two-week visit to California and Florida where she briefed local NCJW Sections on the progress of work on education of the disadvantaged at the NCJW Research Institute For Innovation in Education.

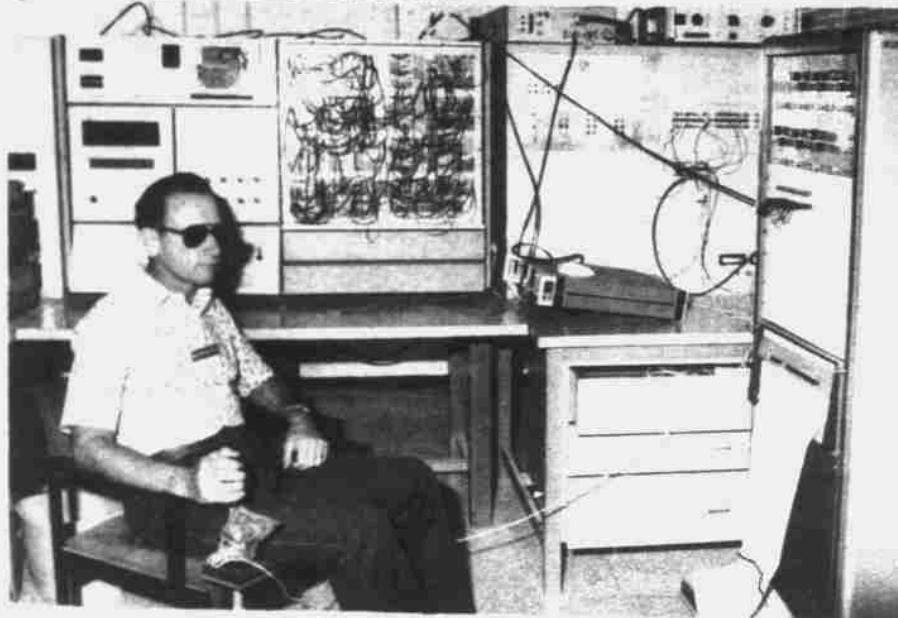
"There is growing awareness of the problems of Israel among Americans," she said, "and a tremendous pride in the knowledge that amidst its political and military problems, Israel is devoting top priority to the educational needs of its disadvantaged population."

"We as a people have always overcome the tremendous odds against us," concluded Mrs. Landa, "and our current crisis is no exception. By redoubling our efforts, we can achieve results which our children may someday look back on with wonder."

The National Council of Jewish Women has devoted its efforts to education in Israel since 1947. NCJW built the Hebrew University High School and for many years granted fellowships to Israeli graduate students for study in the United States. NCJW now has a 10-year commitment to the NCJW Research Institute for Innovation in Education, at the Hebrew University, which is devoted to finding new methods and materials for teaching the disadvantaged.

## NCCJ SYMBOLIZES TRUE AMERICAN SPIRIT

**NEW YORK (WUP)** -- The National Conference of Christians and Jews, founded in 1928 and which held its annual meeting at the Americana Hotel here last week in tribute to three great Americans -- Robert D. Murphy, Brooks Hays and Linwood Holton -- who received the cherished Charles Evans Hughes Award, represents, in the view of this writer, the most outstanding interfaith movement on the American scene in the battle against bigotry, anti-Semitism and racism. In essence, the NCCJ stresses brotherhood and all that this term implies and thus symbolizes the real America in the spirit of the Founding Fathers in faithful conformity with the Declaration of Independence, hence its choice this year as recipients for the

Charles Evans Hughes Award of the three distinguished Americans who by their acts and deeds, have proved faithful to the ideals upon which America was founded

and which serve as the very essence of the NCCJ.

Dr. David Hyatt, the distinguished President of the NCCJ, in explaining the philosophy of the Conference, stated that the credo that "we must learn to live

together as brothers, or die together as fools" is not an empty admonition. In this great nation of ours, it is our uniqueness and incredible heterogeneity which, when combined, have produced not only the richest country in the world, but also a democratic society that truly strives to make real the pledge of allegiance to which we all subscribe but have yet to make a living part of the fabric of our country -- the pledge "One Nation under God, indivisible with liberty and justice for all!"

"Our greatest natural resource is our people! We must remember that human rights are more important than property rights and people more important than things," he declared.

As regards the UN infamy of November 10, the NCCJ was one of the first American national movements to protest in the strongest possible terms.

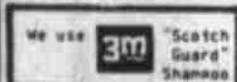
