

**BICENTENNIAL COMMITTEE REMEMBERS PEARL HARBOR DEC. 7**

December 7th, 1975 marks the 34th anniversary of Pearl Harbor. The Las Vegas Bicentennial Committee together with the Pearl Harbor Survivors Assn., has produced a number of activities to commemorate that day which started World War II.

Reed Whipple Cultural Arts Center, 821 Las Vegas Blvd. North is the location of the in-door-out-door event. Opening ceremonies commencing at 9:30 a.m. will include a moment of silence memorial observing the exact time of Pearl Harbor's attack. A "Missing Aircraft" flyover by Nellis AFB personnel will follow. Short addresses will be delivered by the Honorable Keith Ashworth, representing Governor O'Callahan, and Col. George Fox, Commander of the 57th Fighter Wing will represent the Armed Forces.

The United States Marine Corps Flag Pageant begins at 10:15 a.m. The Flag Pageant is a 'one and only time' presentation dramatizing

the history of the American Flag by Marines wearing authentic uniforms of past periods.

The services conclude at 11:00 a.m. at which time the Armed Forces Bicentennial Caravan Exhibit will be available in the North parking lot. There are four vans touring the Western United States; one for each Service, providing a walk-through mini

museum detailing the history of each branch of the Service. Spread over the entire grounds, equipment and special attractions continue until 4:00 p.m. Rolling stock from the Nevada National Guard will flank the vans; Air National Guard will display a helicopter on the ball field; and in adjacent parking lots, the Nellis AFB Drill Team will perform.
