"KEEPSAKE" NEVADA BICENTENIAL BOOK

An editorial advisory board of knowledgeable Nevadans from throughout the state is assisting in the production of a "keepsake" Bicentennial book on Nevada history.

The volume, titled Nevada's Official Bicentennial Book, will contain over 185 stories and 200 pictures and illustrations tracing the state's history from pre-territorial days to the present.

Announcement of the advisory board was made by Secretary of State William D. Swackhamer, chairman of the Nevada Bicentennial Committee, and John Cahlan, vice chairman.

The Board is headed by Stanley Paher, Book Editor, and Thomas C. Elgas, Co-Ordinator and Director.

Named to the Board from Las Vegas are: Mayor Bill Briare, James Deitch, John DuBois, Jess Hinkle, James Joyce, Sheriff Ralph Lamb, Rod Reber, Richard Ronzone, Alex Sample, James Seagrave, Herb Stout, and Maj. Gen. Ralph G. Taylor.

Editorial Board members from Reno are: Tom Draper, Gene Evans, Paul Leonard, Allan Bergendahl, Senator William Raggio, Si Sellers, and Ron Smith. Other members from around the state in-

clude: Guy Shipier, Carson City; Howard Hickson, Elko; George Carnes, Ely; Gerald Roberts, Tonopah; and Cal Sutherland, Winnemucca.

According to Paher, one of Nevada's best known authors, the book will feature vignettes written by non-professional and professional authors who have first-hand knowledge of historic events or materials from private sources relating to Nevada's history.

Paher said more than 100 stories and many pictorial essays have already been submitted. Topical themes included are:

- Famed frontier lawmen Wyatt Earp and his brother Virgil during the Tonopah boom days.

- The slot machine, the only gambling device that is totally American.

- Justice in the Black Rock Desert, a story about wagon train immigrants who settled there without benefit of lawmen or courts.

This bicentennial collection of Nevada history will be available next Spring and is one of the major fund-raising efforts of the Nevada American Revolution Bicentennial Commission.
