the terrorist leaders in Lebanon is that the mayors talk and the PLO shoots.

5. To lay the foundation for resolving the Palestinian issue, the Arab population living under Israeli administration must be given the opportunity to move toward self-government. Out of some 16,000 persons engaged in the administration of the West Bank and Gaza, 15,500 are Arabs. Israel stands, ready (according to Peres) to hand over the other 500 places as well.

6. There are two possible solutions to settling the political future of the Palestinians -- either by giving them autonomy as citizens of a Palestinian-Jordanian state, or by an agreement between Israel and Jordan that will enable the Palestinian people to assert their identity in a European Common Market - type of relationship based on open borders, free trade and other forms of economic and political cooperation with the Jewish state.

These six points offer a useful basis for discussion and debate on the Palestinian issue. The presence of the PLO in the Security Council beginning January 12, however, rules out any kind of constructive approach to the problem.

DISREGARD OF LEBANON CONFLICT PUZZLING

NEW YORK -- A report that President Ford has urged Israel not to interfere in the war between Moslems and Christians in Lebanon is puzzling and disturbing, according to Dr. Joseph P. Sternstein, President of the Zionist Organization of America.

In a statement, Dr. Sternstein warned that "a victory for the Moslems in Lebanon would put the country completely under Syrian

domination and constitute a mortal threat to Israel.

"We cannot remain indifferent to such a development," Dr. Sternstein continued. "Israel has so far made clear that it has no intention of involving itself in the internal war in Lebanon. However, if the United States, the leading Western power, the free world, especially, the world Christian community, will continue to disregard the Moslem war for the
