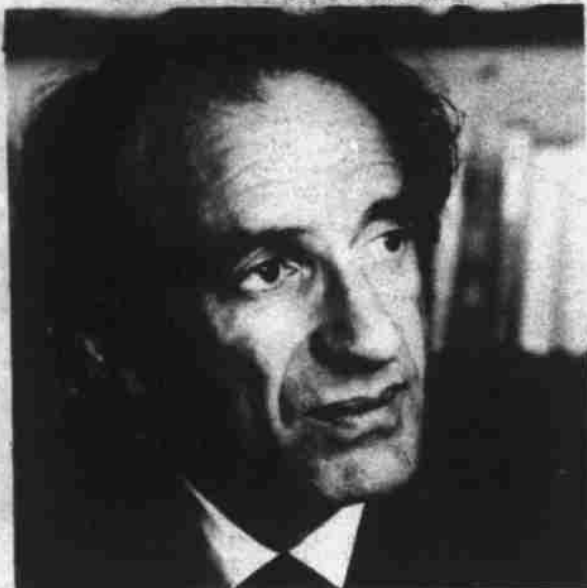

visibly disappointed in the U.S. attitude, Israel celebrated its 27th anniversary by downplaying military displays and emphasizing educational activities.

Congress ripped into Ford's caution. Rep. Claude Pepper of Florida stated, "The only way we can prevent war in the Middle East is to let the world know that the U.S. is not going to permit Israel to become vulnerable to attack by the Arab states."

The diplomatic uncertainty was more concern to Israel than the threat of war. All U.S. aid to Mideast countries was halted, which hit Israel hardest. But King Hussein of Jordan, after a visit with Ford, announced U.S. would supply his country with \$100 million worth of "Hawk" ground-to-air missiles.

About this time, on the local scene, the ISRAELITE exposed a real estate fraud which resulted in a condominium outfit being halted by the courts and finally going out of business.

Israel withdrew troops and the Suez Canal was reopened. Ford denounced a N.Y. Times leak of alleged Israeli peace offers and the Zionist Organization of America accused Ford of a "sellout" to Egypt.

The American Jewish Committee came up with a survey charging that companies that accede to Arab pressure against Jews were breaking the U.S. laws.

Canada nixed a UN conference on crime because the PLO was invited to participate.

The Jewish War Veterans held its 80th National Convention in Las Vegas and Judge Paul Ribner was re-elected national commander. The billion dollar mark was passed for the first time in Nevada gambling revenue before taxes and business expenses were deducted.

The Israeli - Egyptian pact was signed, with Israel giving up strategic passes and vital oil fields, although Egypt still refused to declare non-belligerency.

Sadat visited U.S. on a "Peace Mission" but ripped into Israel at every speech. On this score we disclose for the first time an incident to prove Sadat's pro-Nazi allegiance. It concerned a contest by a Cairo newspaper asking a reply to the question: "If you wanted to send Hitler a letter, what would you write?"

Here is Sadat's reply, as placed in the Congressional Record of October 31 by Rep. Elizabeth Holtzman of N.Y.:

"My dear Hitler: I congratulate you from the bottom of my heart. Even if you appear to have been defeated, in reality you are the victor. You succeeded in creating dissension between Churchill, the old man, and his allies, the Sons of Satan. Germany will win because her existence is necessary to preserve the world balance. Germany will be reborn in spite of the Western and Eastern powers. There will be no peace unless Germany once again becomes what she was. The West, as well as the East, will pay for her rehabilitation....I think you made some mistakes, like too many battlefronts and the shortsightedness of Ribbentrop vis-a-vis the experienced British diplomacy. But your trust in your country and people will atone for those blunders. You may be proud of having become the immortal leader of Germany. We will not be surprised if you appear again in Germany or if a new Hitler rises up in your wake."

This is the man President Ford toasted as "a friend of the United States."

Towards the end of the year came the infamous resolution at the UN equating Zionism with racism. This was the proverbial straw, we believe that will break the back of the UN. The parting blow was a Security Council invitation to the PLO to take part in Middle East peace discussions on January 12, 1976. Israel has refused to attend, despite pressure from the U.S.

Israeli Ambassador Simcha Dinitz said the PLO participation was a victory for Syria in taking the initiative away from the U.S. in favor of Russia.

That's 1975, and good riddance.

UN Rips Indonesia

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- An unusual event took place here last week that had no direct relations to Israel which had been the target of attack almost through the entire 30th session of the General Assembly.

Indonesia, one of the many Moslem states which had joined the Arab-Soviet bloc in voting for the vicious anti-Semitic resolution equating Zionism with racism, found itself the guilty defendant in the Security Council whose fifteen members unanimously adopted a resolution accusing it of armed aggression against the people of East Timor and demanding that it "withdraw without delay all its forces from the territory."

The unusual thing here worth noting was that, although the vote was unanimous, the Communist, Arab and the Third World members of the Council in their accusations struck against Indonesia the hardest blow as compared to the criticism voiced by the Western delegates. The former felt let down and embarrassed that one of their own anti-Israeli comrades-in-arms had so grievously violated the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples by its invasion of East Timor.

Israel's enemies had another let-down the very day they were compelled to attack their 'comrade' Indonesia. The news of the terrorist onslaught on the OPEC members' meeting in Austria struck them like a thunderbolt and only now many of them are demanding that the Assembly meet in a special session to discuss the hitherto shelved agenda item on terrorism which item they had vehemently opposed because it involved their PLO client.

The resolution against Indonesia brought to the attention of the Security Council the just cause of the South Moluccan struggle which issue was originally raised in the Council twenty-five years ago by the late U.S. Ambassador Warren Austin but which had been 'shelved' for adjudication to "a later date" that never came. Expediency as well as immorality ruled the UN then as they do today.

The case of the South Moluccans -- some three million in their home territory and

Shepard Brod

I'd like to meet Shepard Brod. If you ask who he is, you're not from Southern Florida or you don't read the Yiddish Daily Forward.

Mr. Brod is a glittering exemplar of that stress in Judaism on sharing what you have.

Mr. Brod was brought to this country by his devout but learned parents. His father studied and the son followed suit.

Shepard became a lawyer and went to Florida to live. He prospered as a banker too.

Before the Jewish state was formed, David Ben-Gurion came to this country, seeking means and resources for the embryonic state. Among those who responded to his call was Shepard Brod, who risked his security and his life in some daredevil activities in support of the Jewish cause.

Mr. Brod became a developer. He planned and built Bay Harbour, a Miami suburb of which he is the mayor.

Mindful of the fact that in Judaism we are judged not by what we have but by what we do with what we have, Mr. Brod was generous to many causes. He lavishly supported Jewish educational programs.

Recently L. Lasovin of the Forward, disclosed that Mr. Brod gave the University of Miami (down there in Coral Gables) a million dollars department of Jewish studies.

The students will now discover the glory of the teachings of Judaism. They will learn that many Jews cannot feel good unless they serve lofty endeavors.

We might say that school curriculum has been "Brod-ened." Yes indeed, I'd like to meet Mr. Brod. Wouldn't you?
